## **Installing & Using**

Depending on model, country and equipment, registration processes and features of the Porsche Connect services may deviate.

### **Registration and activation**

### Logging in with Porsche ID

- E-mail for registration at My Porsche has been received.
- Log in to My Porsche with the Porsche ID.
   www.porsche.com/myporsche
   On the homepage, an 8-digit pairing code is displayed, which you require for the use of Porsche Connect services in your vehicle.
- 2. Note the pairing code for entry in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM).

## i Information

If you have not received an e-mail for registration with the associated Porsche ID, please contact your Porsche partner.

### Activating services via My Porsche

Before starting to use the Porsche Connect services for the first time, they must be activated.

- 1. Log in to My Porsche with the Porsche ID.
- Select Services.

## i Information

- In some countries, verification of customer identity is required for use of the embedded SIM card for legal reasons. For this purpose, customer identity must be checked by means of an identification document before activation of Porsche Connect services. Verification is performed by a third-party provider (IDnow) in the form of a video call.

## Connecting and pairing the vehicle

## Establishing data connection via embedded SIM (availability dependent on country)

✓ The SIM card reader is empty.

The data connection is established immediately when the ignition is switched on.

### i Information

If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage blackspot).
- Restart the PCM if necessary.

### Displaying data packages

APPS Data packages
 Information about the booked data package is displayed.

## Establishing data connection via external SIM card

An inserted external SIM card deactivates the function of the embedded SIM (availability dependent on country). Additional costs may be incurred for the data connection (e.g. due to data roaming).

#### NOTICE

If you use a SIM card adapter, the SIM card may fall out of the adapter due to vibrations and components of the card may become stuck in the drive.

Do not use adapters for SIM cards.




Fig. 1: Inserting and removing a SIM card

- ✓ The glove box is open.
- Insert external SIM card B (mini-SIM, dimensions: 25 x 15 mm). The missing corner must be at the front left with the chip facing downwards.
- 2. SIM card with PIN:
  - **a.** Enter the PIN code of the SIM card and confirm with **OK**.
  - b. Select Store PIN.
- **3.** Confirm the prompt for establishing the data connection.

The data connection is established.

To remove the external SIM card, press on the inserted card and remove it.

## i Information

If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- PCM phone is switched on.
- External SIM card has sufficient data volume and is inserted correctly.
- External SIM card is not damaged and is working properly.
- APN settings (Internet access) are correct. The APN settings can be checked by contacting the network operator.
- Abroad: Data roaming is allowed on the external SIM card and enabled in the PCM.
- The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage blackspot).
- Restart the PCM if necessary.

### Establishing data connection via external Wi-Fi hotspot

- ✓ Vehicle with embedded SIM (availability dependent on country): PCM phone is switched off.
- ✓ The SIM card reader is empty.
- Select or in the header (depending on the connection status) ► Options WiFi ► Search for WiFi hotspot
- Search for a WiFi hotspot (e.g. public hotspot or the mobile phone's personal hotspot) and enter the WiFi access data in the PCM. When entering the data, pay attention to upper and lower case.

A connection is established to the external WiFi hotspot.

### Logging onto Porsche Connect in the PCM

A pairing code must be entered in the PCM for some services in order to retrieve personal settings from My Porsche.

- 2. Manage Porsche ID ► Link new Porsche ID ► Enter pairing code .
- Enter the pairing code that is displayed after you have successfully activated the services in My Porsche.

#### Remote access authorisation

In order to use services that are controlled via My Porsche or the Porsche Connect App, a remote access authorisation must first be assigned in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM).

- 1. SET **★** ► Porsche Connect
- 2. Select Remote access authorisation ➤ Grant remote access authorisation.
- 3. Confirm message window with Grant.
- 4. Enter the pairing code.

The remote access authorisation can be temporarily deactivated and reactivated via the **Private mode** function.

- 1. SET 

  ▶ Porsche Connect
- 2. Select Private mode ▶ On.

### Security code

The assignment of a security code is necessary for the use of some remote services via the Porsche Connect App or My Porsche.

- 1. Log in to My Porsche with the Porsche ID.
- 2. Select User settings.

The **Security code** must be assigned for use of the following services:

- Opening and locking the vehicle via the Porsche Connect App Please refer to chapter "Lock & Unlock" on page 18.
- Deactivating the Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTS) Please refer to chapter "Switching special mode on and off" on page 20.
- Activation of remote functions for the secondary user

### Using services via My Porsche

Activated services can be configured and used via My Porsche. (country-dependent)

### Updating content in the PCM

### Displaying service overview in the PCM

► APPS ► Options ► Service overview Information about the services purchased and contract duration is displayed.

### Logging out of Porsche Connect in the PCM

- A Porsche Connect user is created and registered.
- 1. APPS → Options Porsche ID settings
- 2. Select the desired Porsche users ► Porsche ID logout

## i Information

- The Porsche Connect services (including the Car Connect services, but not the Safety and Security services) offer a free inclusive period, which varies in length for each services package and country, but is always at least 3 months. Further information about the free inclusive periods as well as subsequent costs and information about the availability of individual services for your country is available online at www.porsche.com/connect or from your Porsche partner.
- Depending on the country, the Porsche Connect Services can be used via the embedded SIM or via a data-enabled, external SIM card. A separate, fee-based contract with a mobile phone provider is required for the external SIM card.
- You may incur additional charges when receiving data packages from the Internet, depending on your mobile phone tariff and whether you are abroad. A flat-rate data plan is recommended.
- The availability, scope and provider of the services may vary depending on the country, model year, device and tariff.

## Apple<sup>®</sup> CarPlay

Apple\* CarPlay makes iPhone\* apps available in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM). You can use the Siri\* voice recognition system to send and answer text messages as well as process voice commands.

## Opening Apple® CarPlay in the PCM




Fig. 2: Smartphone tray in the armrest

- ✓ iPhone® 5 or later, iOS® 7.1 or higher.
- ✓ Siri® and Apple® CarPlay have been enabled in the settings of the iPhone® you are using.
- 1. Connect the iPhone® to the USB port in the smartphone tray in the front armrest.
- Confirm that you wish to use Apple® CarPlay. Available apps are displayed. Apple® CarPlay is opened.
- ► To switch from another function to Apple® Car-Play, select **Apple CarPlay .**

### i Information

- We recommend that you install the latest iOS<sup>®</sup> version.
- Only those apps in the iPhone® that are supported by Apple® CarPlay are displayed. For information on supported apps, go to www.apple.com/ios/carplay.
- The displayed content and features of Apple® CarPlay are provided solely by the connected iPhone®.
- When Apple® CarPlay is used, any active Bluetooth® connections (e.g. for telephony, media playback or news) are automatically disconnected. An inserted SIM card cannot be used for making calls while this app is in use.
- Some apps require an active data connection.
   You may incur additional charges, depending on your mobile phone tariff, and particularly if using abroad. The use of a flat-rate data plan is recommended.

## Operating Apple® CarPlay with PCM

All available apps can be operated via the touch display, the rotary push button and the Back button of the PCM.

- In order to call up the main menu in Apple CarPlay ☑, select the Home button ☑ on the touch display of the PCM.
- ► To switch to the main functions of the PCM, select Apple CarPlay ► Porsche.
  - or –
- Select any function (e.g. MEDIA ]] ).

## Operating Apple® CarPlay using Siri® voice recognition

### Activating Siri®

- ✓ Siri® has been enabled in the settings of the iPhone® you are using.
- ✓ The ignition and PCM are switched on.
- ✓ No telephone call is in progress.
- ✓ ParkAssist is not active.
- PCM voice control is not active.




Fig. 3: Voice control button on control stalk

- 2. Say your desired voice command.

## i Information

Briefly pressing button  $\wp Q$  on the control stalk activates PCM voice recognition.

### Deactivating Siri®

- ✓ Voice control is active and waiting for a voice command.
- Press button ( ) on the control stalk. A fading acoustic signal sounds.

## Switching between Apple® Car-Play and use of the iPhone® as an iPod®

If the connected iPhone® is connected as an iPod®, Apple® CarPlay is not available. You can swap between using the iPhone® as an iPod® and Apple® CarPlay using the Device Manager.

- 1. To call up the Device Manager, select or in the header (depending on the connection status).
- 2. Select the icon **Link** of the iPhone® you are using.

### **Dictate**

You can use the **Message Dictation** service to record a message via voice control.

This service is not available in all languages and markets, and depends on the mobile phone used. Service cannot be used with Apple® devices.

## Connecting mobile phone via Bluetooth

- Mobile phone's Bluetooth® function is activated and visible to other devices.
- ✓ The PCM's Bluetooth® function is activated.

### 1. PHONE ► Search for new phone

- Select a mobile phone from the device list. A 6-digit code is generated and displayed in the PCM and on the mobile phone.
- **3.** Compare the 6-digit code in the PCM and on the mobile phone.
- 4. If the codes match, confirm the code in the mobile phone. On mobile phones with a SIM Access Profile (SAP), enter the PIN for the SIM card in the PCM, if necessary. When the phone is successfully connected, the
  - numeric input is displayed in the PCM.

### Opening voice control




Fig. 4: Voice control button on control stalk

### Activating voice control

- Ignition is switched on.
- No telephone call is in progress.
- Parking aid is not active.
- Briefly press button (p Q on the control stalk.
   A rising acoustic signal sounds and the icon for voice control appears in the PCM.
- 2. Say the voice command.

### **Deactivating voice control**

- ✓ Voice control is active.
- Press button (Q) on the control stalk.
   A fading acoustic signal sounds.

#### Other functions of the voice control button

The w button on the control stalk activates different functions, depending on the application:

- Activates the Siri® voice control system through a longer press.
- Interrupts the current dialogue when pressed briefly.

## i Information

- Navigation announcements and traffic notices are not given during a dialogue.
- With voice control active, list entries can be selected via voice control, the rotary push button or the touch display.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, then voice control responds with the question Excuse me? and the voice command can be repeated after that.

### Notes on communication using voice control

Note the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Speak louder when traveling at higher speeds.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Do not speak when the voice control function is making an announcement.
- Reduce disruptive sounds caused by closing doors, windows and sliding roof.
- Only the driver should issue voice commands, as the hands-free microphone is pointed towards the driver's side.

## Dictating and reading out messages

You can use the **Message Dictation** service to dictate text messages or e-mails, for example, and play incoming messages from the PCM.

### Finder

The **Finder** is the central search function in the Porsche Communication Managements (PCM) navigation. The destinations can be displayed in the current area, along the route, at the destination or at another location. The selected destination can be adopted as a navigation destination and saved as a favourite.

- ✓ Data connection is established.
- Porsche Connect services activated in the Porsche Connect portal.
  - Please refer to chapter "Activating services via My Porsche" on page 3.

### 

You can switch between integrated search in the PCM memory and online search in the Internet via the globe and Google icon next to the input line.

- 2. Icon ► Select the desired option:
- Nearby: Displays destinations in the vicinity of the vehicle.
- Along the route: If route guidance is active, destinations along the route are displayed.
- At destination: If route guidance is active, destinations at the destination are displayed.
- At another location: Destinations at a desired location are displayed.

The following categories can be searched for:

Parking

- Petrol stations
- Hotels
- Restaurants
- E-charging stations (only for E-Hybrid vehicles)
- Select destination. Information such as availability, price information and ratings is displayed.
- 4. Start route guidance to the E-charging station via **Start route guidance**

### **Changing settings**

Various settings such as sort criteria (e.g. sorting of E-charging stations according to distance) can be selected.

## **Navigation Plus**

### Real-time traffic

With the **Real-time traffic** service, the current traffic situation is accessed online in real time and the roads are shown in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) marked in colour according to the traffic situation.



Fig. 6: Traffic situation marked in map view

The following traffic flow information is displayed:

- Orange lines: Slow-moving traffic
- Red lines: Traffic jams

In addition, notifications regarding roadworks, accidents, black spots etc. are displayed.

- Data connection is established.
- ✓ Porsche Connect services are activated in My Porsche
  - Please refer to chapter "Activating services via My Porsche" on page 3.
- 1. NAV ► MAP ► Options ► Navigation settings
- 2. Select Online navigation services ➤ Online navigation.

## My Destinations

Using My Porsche or the Porsche Connect App, it is possible to store destinations, which can be directly retrieved in the PCM.

Data connection is established.

- Porsche Connect services activated in the Porsche Connect portal.
  - Please refer to chapter "Activating services via My Porsche" on page 3.
- Pairing code is entered in the PCM.
  - Please refer to chapter "Logging onto Porsche Connect in the PCM" on page 4.
- 2. Select destination and then **Start route** guidance.

## i Information

Online destinations that were stored under **My Destinations**, are deleted after 30 days.

## Smart routing

A smart route is created automatically as soon as an identical route is travelled twice.

### **Activating smart routing**

- 2. Under Smart routing, activate the function Smart routing.

The symbol is displayed at the bottom right of the map.

### Accessing smart routing

Smart routing is activated.

- 2. Select st the bottom right of the map
- 3. Select the desired smart route from the list of suggestions.
- 4. Select Start

## i Information

- Up to three destinations are created and up to three routes are available for each destination.
   Suggested routes are prioritised according to how frequently an identical route is travelled.
- The traffic situation for available smart routes is displayed depending on the current vehicle position.
- The PCM identifies whether the route is travelled during the week or at the weekend. Recorded smart routes are only displayed at the appropriate time - either at the weekend or on weekdays.
- Opening Smart routing stops active route guidance.

## i Information

Stored smart routes remain stored after the function is deactivated and must be deleted under NAV ✓ ► MAP ✓ ► Options ► Navigation settings ► Smart routing.

## **Online Routing**

With the **Online Routing** option, additional online data is used in the route calculation in order to enable enhanced route guidance.

✓ Data connection is established.

- Porsche Connect services are activated in My Porsche
  - Please refer to chapter "Activating services via My Porsche" on page 3.
- 1. NAV ► MAP Lcon (in the header)
- 2. Select Online Routing.

### Satellite maps

Under the menu item **Google Earth**, satellite data for displaying aerial images of buildings, roads and terrain can be used.

Updates for regions that are relevant for you are searched for automatically. As soon as an update is possible, a relevant notice is displayed in the PCM.

News

You can use the **News** service to display selected news feeds (news channels) or subscribed **Twitter** tweets in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) according to your interests. You can have news and subscribed tweets read out from the PCM using voice control.

## Configuring news and Twitter in My Porsche

Five news feed channels are predefined in the PCM by default. Other news feeds can be added individually via My Porsche.

- Open My Porsche ( www.porsche.com/myporsche) and log in using your access data (Porsche ID and password).
- 2. SelectServices ► News.
- 3. Select the desired option:
- New : For adding new news feeds to the list.
- Search : For locating individual news feeds in the news list.
- Delete : For deleting individual news feeds from the list.
- Pencil icon : For editing news feeds that have already been added.

### Adding a new news feed

- 1. Select New
- 2. Enter the URL of a message portal in the input field.
  - A suggested list of suitable news feeds is displayed.
- **3.** Continue configuring news feed (enter news feed description) and then select **Save**.

- Select news channel via headline quick selection
- 3. Select a news item from the list.

  The item is displayed in the interaction area on the right.
- 4. The text can be read out using the voice function via the speaker icon (Fig. 8). Renewed tapping on the speaker icon terminates the read-out.

## **Parking Plus**

The **Parking Plus** service enables ticket-free access to evopark partner multi-storey car parks with automatic invoicing of parking fees at the end of the month. You can navigate directly to the available multi-storey car parks via the Porsche Communication Management (PCM).

### Installing Parking Plus

- Select the Parking Plus service in the Porsche Connect Store.
- Select Request Parking Plus card. You are then forwarded to the Internet site of our partner evopark.
- Select Order Parking Plus card and enter the required user details.
   The Parking Plus card is delivered by mail.

- 2. Icon ► Select the desired option:
- Nearby: Displays Parking Plus multi-storey car parks in the vicinity of the vehicle.
- At destination: If route guidance is active, Parking Plus multi-storey car parks at the destination are displayed.
  - At another location: Parking Plus multi-storey car parks at a desired location are displayed.
  - Select Parking Plus multi-storey car park.
     Parking Plus multi-storey car parks are indicated by the symbol .
     Information such as parking charge and opening times is displayed.
  - 4. Sort car parks via Options ► Sorting criteria according to distance.
  - 5. Start route guidance to the car park via **Start** route guidance

## **Porsche Connect App**

Various navigation and infotainment functions as well as Car Remote and Car Security services can be operated using the Porsche Connect App.
You can access music tracks with the music streaming function if you have installed the necessary apps or if you have created an account.



Setting and operating while driving

Operating and making settings for the app while driving could distract you from the traffic situation. You may lose control of the vehicle.

Operate and adjust settings only while the vehicle is stationary.

## Installing and using the Porsche Connect App

- Porsche Connect App is installed on your mobile phone (download from App Store\* or GOOGLE\* Play Store).
- ✓ Porsche Connect App has been started.
- ✓ WiFi is enabled on the mobile phone.

- ✓ WiFi function is enabled on the PCM.
  - Please refer to chapter "Establishing data connection via external WiFi hotspot" on page 4.

### Logging in with Porsche ID in Porsche Connect App

## Connecting Porsche Connect App to PCM via WiFi

- Display the WiFi access data of the PCM and establish a WiFi connection between your mobile phone and the PCM.
- 2. In the header, select or or (depending on the connection status) ➤ Options ► PCM hotspot

 $\mbox{\bf Hotspot}$  name and  $\mbox{\bf Password}$  of the PCM are displayed.

**3.** Enter the WiFi access data of the PCM into the WiFi settings on the mobile phone.

### Opening app content in the PCM

 Select APPS ...
 The available content of the Porsche Connect App is displayed.

## Transferring navigation destinations to the PCM

- ✓ Porsche Connect App is connected to the PCM.
- 1. Select a navigation destination in the app.
- My Destinations: Select destination.
- **Calendar**: Select a calendar entry incl. address data.
- Contacts: Select a contact incl. address data.
- Use the symbol to add the destination to the My Destinations favourites list. Entries that were already added to the favourites list are ticked.
- If the Porsche Connect App is connected to the PCM, the content of the My Destinations favourites list is transferred to the PCM.
- 4. In the PCM, select NAV ► FAV ► My Destinations.
- **5.** Start route calculation to the transferred destination.

## Calendar and music streaming

- ✓ The separate music service app has been downloaded and/or you are registered with the music service. Observe information from the music services provider.
- Porsche Connect App is connected to the PCM.

- 1. In the My Account app, select ▶ PCM services.
- 2. In the PCM, select APPS **★ Calendar** or the desired music service.

## i Information

In the **MEDIA** menu under MyMusic, the user can play back existing playlists and tracks stored offline.

### **Smart Home**

Via the Porsche Connect App, certain Smart Home functions are transferred directly to your PCM and can be operated there.

The functions of the Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTS) can be remotely activated/deactivated using the app.

The following special modes are available:

- Service mode: When the mode is activated, no theft alarm is triggered if the vehicle is being serviced (e.g. battery is disconnected).
- Transport mode: When the mode is activated, no theft alarm is triggered if the vehicle is moved with the ignition switched off (e.g. on a ferry).
- Disarmed mode: When the mode is activated, monitoring of the Driver Card is deactivated so that a missing Driver Card no longer triggers an alarm.

With the **Risk Radar** service, the functions **Local Hazard Warning** and **Traffic Sign Detection** are available.

Through the networking of vehicles, separate anonymised information from other vehicles can be accessed. The PCM can therefore indicate hazards in advance and offers optimised traffic sign detection through continuously updated data.




Fig. 14: Voice control button on control stalk

### **Activating voice control**

- ✓ Ignition is switched on.
- No telephone call is in progress.
- ✓ Parking aid is not active.
- Briefly press button ( o on the control stalk.
   A rising acoustic signal sounds and the icon for voice control appears in the PCM.
- 2. Say the voice command.

### **Deactivating voice control**

- ✓ Voice control is active.
- ► Press button ( ) on the control stalk.

  A fading acoustic signal sounds.

#### Other functions of the voice control button

The ( Q button on the control stalk activates different functions, depending on the application:

- Activates the Siri® voice control system through a longer press.
- Interrupts the current dialogue when pressed briefly.

## i Information

- Navigation announcements and traffic notices are not given during a dialogue.
- With voice control active, list entries can be selected via voice control, the rotary push button or the touch display.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, then voice control responds with the question Excuse me? and the voice command can be repeated after that.

### Notes on communication using voice control

Note the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Speak louder when traveling at higher speeds.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Do not speak when the voice control function is making an announcement.
- Reduce disruptive sounds caused by closing doors, windows and sliding roof.
- Only the driver should issue voice commands, as the hands-free microphone is pointed towards the driver's side.
