Installing & Using

Depending on model, country and equipment, registration processes and features of the Porsche Connect services may deviate.

Avoid distractions

If you operate the PCM or other vehicle components while driving, you will be distracted from the traffic situation and may not be able to respond to dangerous situations in time. For your safety, some functions are only available when the vehicle is stationary.

- ▶ Only use the multifunction steering wheel, infotainment system, etc. while driving if the traffic situation allows you to do so safely. If necessary, stop the vehicle in a safe place.
- ▶ Do not use a cellphone or other mobile devices while driving.
- ▶ Only make or receive calls using hands-free equipment.
- ▶ Do not reach between the steering-wheel spokes while driving. Otherwise, you may not be able to react in time to dangerous situations.

Registration and activation

Activating the Porsche ID account and Porsche Connect Services

- ✓ E-mail for activation of the Porsche ID account was received.

1. Tap the "Activate Porsche ID Account" button in the invitation e-mail and enter the

confirmation code sent to the stored cellphone number.

2. Set a password and security code for the Porsche ID account.
3. Complete the profile information and activate the free inclusive Porsche Connect period (availability dependent on country).
4. The My Porsche homepage or app shows the 8-digit pairing code, which you need for using Porsche Connect services in your vehicle.
5. To enter it in the vehicle, send the pairing code in My Porsche to the stored cellphone number via text message.

Information

- **Step 3.** takes place automatically in the background, depending on the country.
- If you have not received an e-mail for activating your Porsche ID, please contact an authorized Porsche dealer.

Activating additional services via My Porsche

Other fee-based services can be activated at any time in the Porsche Connect Store.

- ✓ Porsche ID account activated.


1. Log in to My Porsche with the Porsche ID. (Displayed at the top left of the Porsche website, depending on country.)
2. Select the **Services** tab. Available services are displayed.
3. Select and activate or configure the desired service.

Information

- In some countries, verification of customer identity is required for use of the embedded SIM card for legal reasons. For this purpose, customer identity must be checked by means of an identification document before activation of Porsche Connect services. Verification is performed by a third-party provider (IDnow) in the form of a video call.

Connecting and pairing the vehicle

Establishing data connection via embedded SIM card (availability dependent on country)

- ✓ There is **no** SIM card in the SIM card reader.
- ✓ PCM phone is switched on. (**SET**  **▶ Porsche Connect ▶ Turn on phone features**)

The data connection is established immediately when the ignition is switched on.

Information

If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- PCM phone is switched on.
- The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage blackspot).
- Private mode is deactivated.
- ▶ Restart the PCM if necessary.

Displaying data packages

▶ APPS ▶ Data packages

Information about the booked data package is displayed in some markets.

Establishing a data connection via an external SIM card

An inserted external SIM card deactivates the function of the embedded SIM card (availability dependent on country). Additional costs may be incurred for the data connection (e.g. due to data roaming).


NOTICE

If you are using a SIM card adapter, the SIM card may fall out of the adapter due to vibrations and components of the card may get stuck in the drive.

- ▶ Do not use a SIM card adapter.

- ✓ PCM phone is switched on. (SET  ▶ Porsche Connect ▶ Turn on phone features)

1. Insert external SIM card **B** (mini SIM, dimensions: 0.98 x 0.59 in. (25 x 15 mm)). The missing corner must be pointing front left with the chip facing down.

2. SIM card **with** PIN:

- Enter the PIN for the external SIM card and confirm with **OK**.
- Select **Store PIN**.

3. Confirm the prompt for establishing the data connection.

The data connection is established.

4. To remove the external SIM card, press on the inserted card and remove.

Information




If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- PCM phone is switched on.
 - External SIM card has sufficient data volume and is inserted correctly.
 - External SIM card is not damaged and is working properly.
 - APN settings (Internet access) are correct. The APN settings can be checked by contacting the network provider.
 - In foreign countries: Data roaming is allowed on the external SIM card and enabled in the PCM.
 - The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage blackspot).
- ▶ Restart the PCM if necessary.


Selecting access point for external SIM card




If several access points are available, the message **Several access points (APN) are available. Please select one** appears. A list of available access points (APNs) is displayed.

- Select the desired access point (APN).
- If there is no access point configured, you should contact the service provider to obtain the APN settings. To configure the APN

settings, select  or  (depending on the connection status) ▶ Options  ▶ **Data connections** ▶ **Reset access point configuration** in the header.

Establishing data connection via external Wi-Fi hotspot (availability dependent on country)



- ✓ There is **no** SIM card in the SIM card reader.
- ✓ Vehicles with embedded SIM card (availability dependent on country): PCM phone is switched off. (SET  ▶ Porsche Connect ▶ Turn off phone features)

1. Select  or  in the header (depending on the connection status) ▶ Options  ▶ **WiFi** ▶ **Search for WiFi Hotspot**


2. Select a WiFi hotspot (e.g. public hotspot or the cellphone's personal hotspot) and enter WiFi access data in the PCM. Be aware of upper and lower case when entering the data. A connection is established to the external WiFi hotspot.

Logging in Porsche ID

The Porsche ID is linked to the PCM using a pairing code. This is required for using some Connect services in order to retrieve personal settings from My Porsche.


1. APPS  ▶ Options  ▶ **Porsche ID settings** ▶ **Link new Porsche ID**

2. Enter the pairing code.
 ▶ Please see chapter "Registration and activation" on page 3.


User is logged in and the symbol  appears in the header.

Granting remote access authorization

In order to use services that are controlled via My Porsche or the app, remote access authorization must first be granted in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM).

1. SET  ► **Porsche Connect**
2. Select **Remote access authorization** ► **Grant remote access authorization**.
3. Confirm message window with **Grant**.
4. Enter the main user's pairing code.

Remote access authorization can be temporarily deactivated and reactivated via the function **Private mode** for **all** services or for **individual services**.

1. SET  ► **Porsche Connect**
2. Select **Private mode** ► **On**.
Communication between the vehicle and the app as well as My Porsche is suppressed.

No vehicle-specific information can be transferred, and no vehicle settings can be made via the app or My Porsche.

Security code

The assignment of a security code is necessary for the use of certain remote services via the app or My Porsche.

1. Call up My Porsche.
(Displayed at the top left of the Porsche website, depending on country.)
2. Log in using your personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. The security code can be set, changed or reset in the user settings.

The **Security code** must be assigned e.g. for use of the following services:

- Opening and locking the vehicle using the app
- Deactivating the Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTs)
- Activation of remote functions for the secondary user

Configuring & Using



Using services via My Porsche

Activated services can be configured and used via My Porsche (available in some countries).



1. Call up My Porsche.
(Displayed at the top left of the Porsche website, depending on country.)
2. Log in using your personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. Select **Services**.

Updating content in the PCM



- **APPS**  ► Options  ► **Reload page**
The contents of the purchased services are updated.

Displaying service overview in the PCM

- **APPS**  ► Options  ► **Service overview**
Information about the services purchased and contract duration is displayed.

Logging Porsche ID out of PCM

- ✓ A Porsche Connect user is created and registered.

1. **APPS**  ► Options  ► **Porsche ID settings**
2. Select the desired Porsche user ► **Logout Porsche ID**

Information

- The Porsche Connect services (including the Car Connect services, but not the Safety and Security services) offer a free inclusive period, which varies in length for each services package and country, but is always at least 3 months. Further information about the free inclusive periods as well as subsequent costs and information about the availability of individual services for your country is available online at www.porsche.com/connect or from your authorized Porsche dealer.
- Depending on the country, the Porsche Connect services can be used via the embedded SIM card or a data-enabled external SIM card. A separate, fee-based contract with a cellphone service provider is required for the external SIM card.
- Additional costs may be incurred for receiving data from the Internet, depending on the cellphone rate plan, particularly when the system is used in foreign countries. We recommend a data flat rate.
- Service availability and scope, as well as service providers, may vary from country to country, model year, device and tariff.

Topics

On the following pages, the content is arranged in topics in alphabetical order.

Apple CarPlay

Apple CarPlay makes iPhone apps available in Porsche Communication Management (PCM). You can use the Siri voice recognition system to send and answer text messages, as well as process voice commands.

i Information

Apple CarPlay® must be selected when connecting for the first time. It is then possible to switch between iPod and Apple CarPlay as desired.

i Information

- Recommendation: Install the latest iOS version.
- Only those apps in the iPhone that are supported by Apple CarPlay TM can be displayed. For information on supported apps, go to www.apple.com/ios/carplay.
- The function can only be offered in countries supported by Apple. For information on supported countries: refer to www.apple.com/ios/feature-availability/#apple-carplay.
- The content and functions displayed within the Apple CarPlay TM function are provided exclusively by the connected iPhone.
- When Apple CarPlay TM is used, active Bluetooth® connections (such as telephony, media playback, or messages) are automatically disconnected.
- Some apps require an active data connection. You may incur additional charges, depending on your cellphone tariff, and particularly if using abroad. The use of a flat-rate data plan is recommended.

Opening Apple CarPlay in the PCM

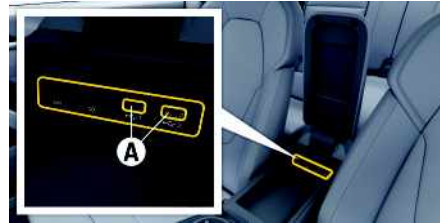




Fig. 2: USB port (type C) in the armrest


- ✓ iPhone 7 or later, iOS 14 or higher.
- ✓ Siri and Apple CarPlay have been enabled in the settings of the iPhone that you are using.
- ✓ For flawless operation use original Apple cables that are undamaged and that do not have a USB adapter.



1. Connect your iPhone to the USB port (type C) A in the armrest.
2. Confirm the notice that Apple CarPlay is being used.
Apple CarPlay is opened. The available apps are displayed.

- ▶ To switch from another menu item to Apple CarPlay, select **Apple CarPlay** 
 - or -
 - Select **Apple CarPlay**  in the status bar.

Operating Apple CarPlay with the PCM

All available apps can be operated via the touch display, the rotary push button and the Back button of the PCM.

- ▶ To access the main menu within **Apple CarPlay**, select the Home button  on the PCM touch display.

- ▶ To switch to the main functions of the PCM, select **Apple CarPlay** ▶ Home button  ▶ **Porsche** .

- or -

- ▶ Select any function (e.g. **MEDIA** ).


Operating Apple CarPlay via Siri voice recognition

Starting Siri

- ✓ Siri has been enabled in the settings of the iPhone that you are using.
- ✓ The ignition and PCM are switched on.
- ✓ There are no active phone calls.
- ✓ ParkAssist is not active.
- ✓ PCM voice control is not active.



Fig. 3: Voice control button on the steering wheel





Ending Siri

- ✓ Siri is active and awaiting a voice command.
- ▶ Press the  button on the steering wheel. A fading acoustic signal sounds.

Switching between Apple CarPlay and use of the iPhone as an iPod





If the connected iPhone is connected as iPod, Apple CarPlay is not available. Use the Device Manager to switch between use of the iPhone as an iPod or Apple CarPlay.

1. To open the Device Manager, select  or  (depending on the connection status) in the header.
 - or –
 - Devices** 
2. Select the **Apple CarPlay**  icon for the iPhone you are using.
 - or –
 - Select the **iPod**  icon for the iPhone you are using. The icon for the iPhone you are currently using is highlighted in color

Opening Wireless Apple CarPlay (available in some countries)



Wireless CarPlay allows you to use Apple CarPlay without a cable. Wireless CarPlay only supports one active cellphone at a time.

- ✓ Bluetooth® and WiFi functions activated on the cellphone and visible for other devices.
- ✓ Wireless CarPlay activated on the cellphone.
- ✓ Bluetooth® and WiFi functions of the vehicle activated.



1. In the status area, select  or  (depending on the connection status) and select ▶ **Apple CarPlay Search** in the menu under Connection manager.
 - or –
 - Devices**  ▶ **Link** 

2. Select the device from the list.
3. Confirm the notice that Apple CarPlay is being used. Apple CarPlay is opened. Available apps are displayed.




After you have connected your iPhone once, Apple CarPlay starts automatically whenever you get into the vehicle. You can leave the cellphone in your bag or trouser pocket, for example (Bluetooth® function and WiFi function must be activated). Alternatively, Wireless CarPlay can be reconnected via:



1. **Devices** 
2. Select the  symbol on the iPhone you are using.

To switch from another menu item to Apple CarPlay:



- ▶ Select **Apple CarPlay** 
- or –
- Select **Apple CarPlay**  in the status area.

Deleting a stored iPhone from the list of devices

1. Select  or  in the header (depending on the connection status) ▶ **Options** 
- or –

- Select **Devices**  ▶ **Options** 
- 2. Select the desired device.

Ending Wireless CarPlay


1. Select **Devices** 
2. Select the  symbol on the iPhone you are using. Wireless CarPlay is ended.

Dictation

You can use the **Message Dictation** service to record a message via voice control.




This service is not available in all languages and markets, and depends on the cellphone used.

Voice control can be interrupted in order to say other voice commands. Activating/deactivating voice control interruption in the PCM:

- ▶ Select **SET**  ▶ **System settings** ▶ **Voice control** ▶ **Interrupt voice control**.

Connecting a cellphone via Bluetooth®

- ✓ The Bluetooth® function of the cellphone is activated and is visible for other devices.
- ✓ The PCM Bluetooth® function is activated.




1. Select  or  **Search for new device** in the header.
2. Select a cellphone from the device list. A 6-digit Bluetooth® code is generated and displayed in the PCM and on the cellphone.
3. Compare the Bluetooth® code in the PCM and on the cellphone.
4. If the Bluetooth® code in the PCM and on the cellphone match, confirm. Enter the PIN for the external SIM card in the PCM if necessary. When the phone is successfully connected, the numeric input (**KEYPAD** menu ) is displayed in the PCM.

Information

- Depending on the Bluetooth® capability of the cellphone, it is possible to access the content of the phone book, call lists and messages. It is also possible to transfer an ongoing conversation to the cellphone after parking the vehicle and continue it outside the vehicle if the cellphone supports this function.

Connecting a cellphone (Windows® and iOS operating system)

For cellphones with Windows® and iOS operating systems, it is recommended to start connection from the cellphone:

1. Search for available devices in the Bluetooth® menu of the cellphone. Select  or  in the header (depending on the connection status) to make the PCM visible.
2. Select the PCM from the list of available devices. The Bluetooth® device name of the PCM can be displayed in the **Device Manager** under Options  ▶ **Bluetooth** ▶ **Bluetooth name**.

Opening voice control

 **WARNING** Impaired speech recognition

Your voice can change in stressful situations. This could prevent the desired telephone connection from being established or from being established



fast enough.

- ▶ Do not use voice control in an emergency.
- ▶ Enter the emergency number via the touch display.

Activating voice control

- ✓ Ignition is switched on.
 - ✓ There are no active phone calls.
 - ✓ ParkAssist not active.
1. Briefly press the  button on the steering wheel. A rising acoustic signal is heard and the symbol  for voice control appears on the PCM.
 2. Say the voice command.

Deactivating voice control


- ✓ Voice Control is active.
- ▶ Press the  button on the steering wheel. A fading acoustic signal sounds.

Information

The dialog can be paused by tapping on the microphone symbol  and started again by tapping again.

Further voice control button functions

The  button on the control lever can activate different functions, depending on the application:

- Skips a running announcement when pressed briefly.
- Interrupts the current dialog when pressed briefly.
- Activated by pressing and holding Siri voice recognition.

Information

- Navigation and traffic notices are not issued during a dialog.
- With voice control active, list entries can be selected using voice control, the rotary push button or the touch display.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, voice control responds with the question **Excuse me?** and the voice command can be repeated after that.

Notes on communication using voice control

Observe the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Do not speak when the voice control function is making an announcement.
- Reduce disruptive noises by closing the doors, windows and sliding roof.
- Only the driver should issue voice commands, as the hands-free microphone is pointed toward the driver's side.

Dictating and reading out messages

You can use the **Message Dictation** service to dictate text messages or e-mails, for example, and play incoming messages from the PCM.

- ✓ Data connection established.
- ✓ Porsche Connect services activated in My Porsche.
 - Please see chapter "Installing & Using" on page 3.
- ✓ The connected cellphone supports the function.
- ✓ Voice Control is active.

Dictating messages

Service cannot be used with Apple devices.

- Say the voice command:

Dictate (new) e-mail

- or -

Dictate (new) text message

The dictated message is displayed in the PCM for the user to check.

Reading out messages

- Say the voice command:

Read out e-mails

- or -

Read out text messages

The message is read out.

Finder

The **Finder** is the central search function for the Porsche Communication Management (PCM). Information about destinations such as restaurants, hotels, gas stations or parking lots can be found in the Finder.



Destinations in the current area, along the route, at the destination location, or at another location can be displayed. The selected destination can be adopted as a navigation destination and saved as a favorite.

1. Select NAV ► in the header.

By clicking the Globe and Google icon next to the search bar, you can change between an integrated search in the PCM's memory and online content  as well as an Internet online search .

2. Select destination.

Information such as availability, price or ratings is displayed (availability dependent on country).

3. Start route guidance

Search point of interest

- ✓ Data connection established.
- ✓ Porsche Connect services activated in My Porsche.

1. Select NAV ► DEST ► Points of interest

2. The following categories, for example, can be searched for:

- **Parking Information**
- **Gas stations**
- **Hotels**
- **Restaurants**

3. Icon in the header ► Select the desired option:

- **Nearby:** Displays destinations in the vicinity of the vehicle.
- **Along route:** If route guidance is active, destinations along the route are displayed.
- **At destination:** If route guidance is active, destinations at the destination location are displayed.
- **At another location:** Destinations at a desired location are displayed.

A My Porsche

B My Porsche is the central platform for managing your vehicles and using relevant services and is the starting point for other available functions and services. Access to My Porsche is via your personal Porsche ID. You can configure personal settings relating to data synchronization and data processing in your Porsche ID account.

C The platform also provides various options for arranging service appointments, for example.

D The services and functions that are available depend on the model, country and equipment.

Adding a navigation destination

- E** ✓ E-mail for registration at My Porsche received.
- F** ✓ Porsche ID account activated.

1. Select the **Services** tab in My Porsche.
Available services are displayed.

2. Select the **Navigation Plus** service.

3. Select **Add new destination**.

4. Enter destination data.
The destination is displayed in My Porsche and can be edited, marked, deleted or sent to the vehicle.

Navigation Plus

Real-time Traffic

The **Real-time Traffic** service checks the current, real-time traffic volume online, and color-codes the streets in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) according to the traffic situation.

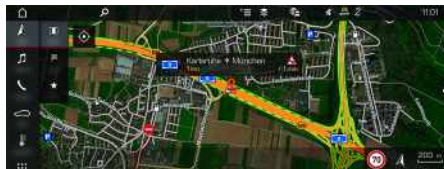


Fig. 6: Traffic situation marked in map view

The following traffic flow information is displayed:

- Green lines: Free-flowing traffic
- Yellow lines: Slow-moving traffic
- Red lines: traffic jam
- Dark red lines: Closed roads

In addition, the navigation map displays notices for construction sites, accidents, hazards, etc.

Activating Real-time Traffic

- ✓ Data connection established.
- ✓ Porsche Connect services activated in My Porsche.
 - Please see chapter "Installing & Using" on page 3.

1. NAV ► MAP ► Options ► **Navigation settings**

2. Select **Online navigation services** ► **Online navigation**.

When route guidance is active, messages are displayed in the navigation map. A status

symbol appears in the header when real-time traffic is active.

Viewing Real-time Traffic notice

Details are displayed by opening a Real-time Traffic notice.

- ✓ Data connection established.

2. Activate **Smart routes** under the **Smart routes** function.

The symbol is displayed in the lower right corner of the map.

Information

- Up to three destinations are created and up to three routes are available for each destination. Suggested routes are prioritized according to how frequently an identical route is traveled.
- The traffic situation for available smart routes is displayed depending on the current vehicle position.

News


You can use the **News** service to display selected news feeds (news channels) or subscribed **Twitter** tweets in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) according to your interests. You can have news and subscribed tweets read out from the PCM using voice control.

Configuring News and Twitter in My Porsche

Five news feed channels are predefined in the PCM by default. Other news feeds can be added individually via My Porsche.

1. Call up My Porsche.
(Displayed at the top left of the Porsche website, depending on country).
2. Log in using your personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. Select **Services** ▶ **News**.
4. Select the desired option:
 - **New** : For adding new news feeds to the list.
 - **Search** : For locating individual news feeds in the news list.
 - **Delete** : For deleting individual news feeds from the list.
 - **Pencil icon** : For editing news feeds that have already been added.

Adding a new news feed

1. Select **New** .
2. Enter the URL of a message portal in the input field.

A suggested list of suitable news feeds is displayed.




3. Continue configuring the news feed (enter news feed description) and then select **Save**.

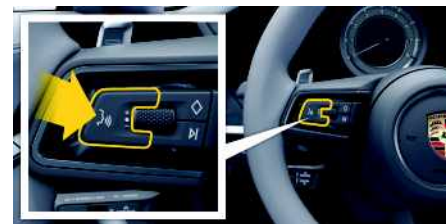




Fig. 10: Voice control button on the steering wheel

Porsche Connect App¹

The app, which is available in some countries, can be used to network the cellphone with the vehicle. This allows vehicle-specific information to be retrieved directly via the cellphone and selected vehicle settings to be made from the app.

WARNING Setting and operating while driving

Operating and making settings for the app while driving could distract you from the traffic situation. You may lose control of the vehicle.

- ▶ Operate and adjust settings only while the vehicle is stationary.

Personal POIs (Points of Interest), destinations from the address book or calendar entries, for example, can be transferred to the PCM from the cellphone.

Installing & using App

Logging Porsche ID into the app

1. Select **Login or registration** when starting the app.

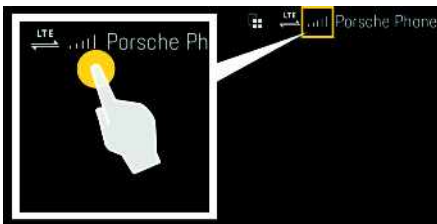


Fig. 11: Opening the Device Manager

The connection status allows you to check the connection between the app/cellphone, the Porsche server and the vehicle.

- ✓ Private mode is deactivated on the PCM.

If a connection to the vehicle cannot be established, check the following:





- Private mode is deactivated
- Data connection is established
- The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage dead zone)
- Vehicle is connected to the app.

If the Porsche server cannot be reached, contact Porsche Connect Support or your authorized Porsche dealer depending on the country.

Driving data is displayed on various levels.

3. Select **All trip data**.

The current driving data is displayed. Further driving data can be displayed by swiping to the left/right.

Information

Driving data can be reset in the multifunction display on the instrument panel. For further information on the multifunction display, please refer to the separate Owner's Manual.

Car Finder

The vehicle position and that of the cellphone are displayed on the navigation map.

1. Select **Explore** in the app's main area.
2. By tapping on the bottom right of the cross hairs, the map is aligned so that both vehicle and cellphone positions are displayed.

By tapping on the vehicle, navigation from the cellphone position to the vehicle can be started.

Lock & Unlock

- ✓ Vehicle is stationary and ignition is switched off.
- ✓ Driver's door fully closed.
- ✓ Security code assigned in My Porsche.
 - ▶ Please see chapter "Installing & Using" on page 3.

1. Select **My Car** in the app main area.
2. Select unlocked or locked lock.

The vehicle doors and the tailgate are unlocked or locked. The alarm system is activated and the lock symbol is displayed when locking.

A Using the alarm function

The individual alarm functions are available depending on country. The following conditions must be met to use the full scope of functions:

- ✓ Private mode is deactivated.
- ✓ Remote access authorization granted in the PCM.

H Car Alarm

If the vehicle alarm system is triggered, a push notification with information on the type and time of the alarm is sent directly to the cellphone.

L Location-, Speed- and Valet Alarm

1. Select **My Car** in the app main area.
2. Move down by swiping downwards (**Alarms and Modes**).
3. Select **Change settings**.
4. Selecting the desired alarm.

- **Location:** A geographical area can be defined. If the vehicle enters or leaves this area, an alarm message is sent.
- **Speed:** A limit speed is specified. If this limit speed is exceeded, an alarm message is sent.
- **Valet:** A preconfigured combination of the Location and Speed Alarm can be activated. If a parameter is exceeded, an alarm message is sent.

Geographical areas and limit speeds can be added and activated via the **Add alarm** function.

Stored geographical areas and limit speeds can be edited or deleted via the **Edit** function.

i Information

Changes to limit settings affect all app users that access the same vehicle.

Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTS)

The functions of the Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTS) can be remotely activated/deactivated using the app.

The following special modes are available:

- **Service mode:** When the mode is activated, no theft alarm is triggered if the vehicle is being serviced (e.g. battery is disconnected).
- **Transport mode:** When the mode is activated, no theft alarm is triggered if the vehicle is moved with the ignition switched off (e.g. on a ferry).

NOTICE

Please use these functions carefully.

- ▶ Activation of the special modes temporarily restricts the security of your vehicle.

Porsche Track Precision app¹

The app, which is available in some countries, can be used to connect to the vehicle via a wireless local network (WiFi). This enables driving data to be displayed, recorded and analyzed directly on a cell-phone. You do not necessarily need a SIM card/data connection to use the app.

DANGER

Loss of control over the vehicle

Driving at excessive speeds and risky maneuvers may lead to loss of control over the vehicle.

Porsche Voice Pilot

You can use the **Porsche Voice Pilot** service to operate selected functions in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) by voice command.

The **Porsche Voice Pilot** service is not available in all languages and markets.

Voice control can be interrupted in order to say other voice commands. Activating/deactivating voice control interruption in the PCM:

- ▶ Select **SET**  ▶ **System settings** ▶ **Voice control** ▶ **Interrupt voice control**.

Opening voice control



WARNING

Impaired speech recognition



Your voice can change in stressful situations. This could prevent the desired telephone connection from being established or from being established fast enough.

- ▶ Do not use voice control in an emergency.
- ▶ Enter the emergency number via the touch display.




Fig. 12: Voice control button on the steering wheel

Deactivating voice control


- ✓ Voice control is active.
- ▶ Press the  button on the steering wheel.
A fading acoustic signal sounds.



Information

The dialog can be paused by tapping on the microphone symbol  and started again by tapping again.

Further voice control button functions

The  button on the control lever can activate different functions, depending on the application:

- Skips a running announcement when pressed briefly.
- Interrupts the current dialog when pressed briefly.
- Activated by pressing and holding Siri voice recognition.



Information

- Navigation and traffic notices are not issued during a dialog.
- With voice control active, list entries can be selected using voice control, the rotary push button or the touch display.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, voice control responds with the question **Excuse me?** and the voice command can be repeated after that.

Notes on communication using voice control

Note the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Do not speak when the voice control function is making an announcement.
- Reduce disruptive noises by closing the doors, windows and sliding roof.
- Only the driver should issue voice commands, as the hands-free microphone is pointed toward the driver's side.

Radio Plus

With the **Radio Plus** service it is possible to switch between the Internet radio and the hybrid radio. The Internet radio receives radio stations online, the hybrid radio automatically selects the best possible reception.

Opening Internet radio

With the Internet radio integrated in the PCM, online channels of radio stations can be received.

Station categorization

The Internet radio stations can be selected according to the categories popularity, country, genre and language.

1. Select **MEDIA** ▶ **LIST** .
2. Select the desired category, e.g. **Genre**.

Activating the hybrid radio

The **Hybrid radio** function enables continuous perfect reception. If the FM reception is subject to environmental interference, the PCM automatically receives the radio station online when the function is active.

- ✓ Media source **FM** is selected.

1. Select **MEDIA** ▶ **Options** .
2. Activate **Tuner settings** ▶ **Online station tracking**.
If reception is weak, stations are automatically received online and **Online** appear under the station name.

Setting streaming quality

In order to restrict data usage, the streaming quality for the reception of Internet radio stations can be set.

1. Select **MEDIA** ▶ **PLAY** .
2. Select Media source (in the header) ▶ **Online**.
3. **Options** ▶ **Streaming quality**

Activating/deactivating additional online data

With this option, additional metadata and album covers are displayed.

1. Select **MEDIA**.
2. Select **Options** ▶ **Tuner settings** ▶ **Additional online information**.

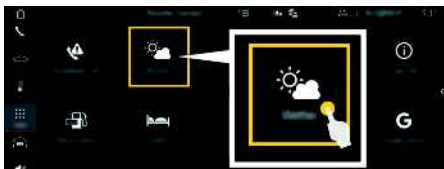


Fig. 14: Weather

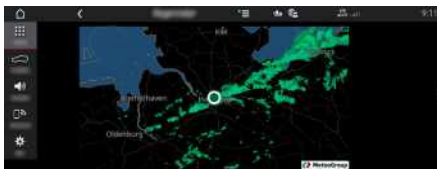


Fig. 15: Rain Radar
