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Registration and Setup

Important information about Porsche Connect

Availability

The availability of Porsche Connect varies depending on the country and equipment. Accordingly, the contents described may differ.

Data connection

A data connection is required in order to use Porsche Connect Services. The data connection can be established via the embedded SIM card or an external WiFi hotspot, depending on the country.

Information

For legal reasons, customer identity verification is required to use the **integrated SIM card** in some countries. For this purpose, the customer's identity must be verified by means of an identity document before the activation of the Porsche Connect services. Verification is performed by a third-party provider (ID-now) in the form of a video call.

The currently active data connection is displayed in the status area of the PCM and in the Device Manager.

Use while driving

If the PCM or other components in the vehicle are operated while driving, there is a risk of being distracted while driving, and it may not be possible to react to dangerous situations in time. For this reason, some functions are only available when the vehicle is stationary.

1. Only use the multi-function steering wheel, infotainment system, etc., while driving if the traffic situation allows you to do so safely. If necessary, stop the vehicle in a safe place.
2. Do not use a cellphone or other mobile device while driving.
3. Only make or receive calls using hands-free equipment.
4. Do not reach between the steering wheel spokes while driving. Otherwise, you may not be able to react in time to dangerous situations.

Apps

Various apps are available for your vehicle, depending on the country (download from Apple App Store or GOOGLE® Play Store).

WARNING

Setting and operating while driving

Configuring settings and operating apps while driving can distract you from the traffic situation. You may lose control of the vehicle.

- Operate and adjust settings only while the vehicle is stationary.

Registration and activate My Porsche

My Porsche is the central platform for managing personal vehicles, using relevant services and a contact point for further offers. Access to My Porsche is via the personal Porsche ID.

The Porsche ID is a verified email address that is used as Porsche ConnectUser in My Porsche the Porsche Connect Store and in the Porsche Connect App.

In the Porsche ID account, the user is given the ability to make personal settings regarding data synchronization and processing. The platform also offers other options for scheduling service appointments, for example.

The services and functions are available depending on the country and equipment.

Log in My Porsche to access

✓ Porsche ID account is activated.

1. Open My Porsche
(Access can be found at the top left of the Porsche website depending on country.)
2. Enter and open the login data (Porsche ID and password).

Activate Porsche ID account (Porsche Connect user) and Porsche Connect services

✓ E-mail was received to activate the Porsche ID account.

1. Click the "Activate Porsche ID Account" button in the e-mail and enter the confirmation code (sent to the cell phone number on file).
2. **Set the password and security code** for the Porsche ID account.
3. Complete profile details and activate the free Porsche Connect inclusive period, which is available in some countries. (Automatically performed in the background depending on the country)
4. The My Porsche home page displays the 8-digit pairing code that you need to use Porsche Connect services in your vehicle.
5. For entry in Porsche Communication Management (PCM), send the pairing code to the cell phone number on file in My Porsche by text message.
– or –
Note the pairing code.

If no e-mail was received to activate the Porsche ID, please contact your Porsche partner.

Configure services

✓ Porsche ID account is activated.

1. Open My Porsche
2. Log in with personal access data (Porsche ID and password).

3. Select the **Services** tab.
➔ Available services are displayed.
4. Select the desired service.
5. Activate and configure.

i Information

- The Porsche Connect Service package includes many Porsche Connect services for a free inclusive period, which can be different for each service and country. More information about the free inclusive periods as well as subsequent costs and information about the availability of individual services is available online at **www.porsche.com/connect** or from your authorized Porsche dealer.
- Depending on the country, the Porsche Connect services are used via the embedded SIM card or the external WiFi hotspot (only available for Russia).
- Additional costs may be incurred for receiving data from the Internet, depending on the cell-phone rate plan, particularly when the system is used in foreign countries. We recommend a data flat rate.
Service availability and scope, as well as service providers, may vary from country to country, model year, device and tariff.

Add navigation destination

Navigation destinations can be defined either in the My Porsche portal or directly in the vehicle.

Adding a navigation destination in the My Porsche portal

✓ Porsche ID account is activated.

1. Open My Porsche
2. Log in with personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. Select the **Services** tab.
 - ➔ Available services are displayed.
4. Select **Navigation Plus** service.
5. Select **Add new destination**
6. Enter destination data.
 - ➔ Destination is displayed in My Porsche and can be edited, marked, deleted or sent to the vehicle.

Connect & pair vehicle

Establishing data connection via an embedded SIM

Establishing data connection via embedded SIM card (availability dependent on country).

- ✓ There is no SIM card in the SIM card reader.
- ✓ PCM phone is switched on. (SET ⚙️ ▶ Porsche Connect ▶ Turn on phone features)

The data connection is established immediately when the ignition is switched on.

i Information

If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- PCM phone is switched off.
 - The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage blackspot).
 - Private mode deactivated.
- ▶ If necessary, Restart PCM.

Displaying data packages

▶ APPS 📶 ▶ Data packages

- ➡ Depending on the market, information about the booked data package is displayed.

Establishing a data connection via an external SIM card

An inserted external SIM card deactivates the function of the embedded SIM card (availability dependent on country). Additional costs may be incurred for the data connection (e.g. due to data roaming).

NOTE

If a SIM card adapter is used, there is a risk of the SIM card falling out of the adapter due to vibrations and components of the card getting stuck in the drive.

- ▶ Do not use a SIM card adapter.



Fig. 1: Insert an external SIM card into the armrest

- ✓ PCM phone is switched on. (SET ⚙️ ▶ Porsche Connect ▶ Turn on phone features)

1. Insert external SIM card B (Fig. 1) (mini-SIM, dimensions: 25 x 15 mm). The missing corner must be pointing front left with the chip facing down.
2. SIM card with PIN:
 - a. Enter the PIN code of the external SIM card and confirm with **OK**.
Save PIN Select b.
3. Confirm the prompt for establishing the data connection.
 - ➡ The data connection is established.
4. To remove the external SIM card, press on the inserted card and remove the card.

i Information

If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- PCM phone is switched off.
- External SIM card has sufficient data volume and is inserted correctly.
- External SIM card is not damaged and is working properly
- APN settings (Internet access) are correct. The APN settings can be checked by contacting the network provider.
- Abroad: Data roaming is allowed on the external SIM card and enabled in the PCM.
- The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage blackspot).

- ▶ If necessary, Restart PCM.

Selecting access point for external SIM card




If multiple access points are available, the message **Several access points are available. Select an access point to establish a data connection.** may appear. A list of available access points (APNs) is displayed.

1. Select the desired access point (APN).
2. If there is no access point configured, you should contact the service provider to obtain the APN settings. To configure the APN settings, select or (depending on the connection status) ▶ Options ≡ ▶ Data connections ▶ Reset access point configuration in the header.

Establishing data connection via external WiFi hotspot




Data connection via external WiFi hotspot is available depending on the country.

- ✓ There is **no** SIM card in the SIM card reader.
- ✓ Vehicles with embedded SIM (availability dependent on country):
PCM phone is switched off. (SET ⚙️ ▶ Porsche Connect ▶ Turn off phone features)

1. In the header  or  (depending on the connection status), search for Options  ▶ WiFi ▶ WiFi hotspot
2. Select a WiFi hotspot (e.g. public hotspot or the cell phone's personal hotspot) and enter the WiFi access data in the PCM. Be aware of upper and lower case when entering the data.
 - ➔ A connection is established to the external WiFi hotspot.

Log in Porsche Connect user (Porsche ID) in PCM.

The Porsche ID is linked to the PCM via a pairing code. This is necessary for using some Connect services to retrieve personal settings from My Porsche.

1. APPS  ▶ Link  ▶ Porsche ID settings ▶ ID options
2. Enter the pairing code that is displayed under My Porsche after successful activation of the services.
 - ➔ User is logged in, symbol  appears in the header.

Private mode

When private mode is activated, communication between the vehicle and the app as well as My Porsche is suppressed. No vehicle-specific information is transferred. This means that no vehicle settings can be configured via the app or My Porsche.

- ▶ Please inform all persons using the vehicle that communication may be suppressed.

Activate private mode

- ▶ Select SET ⚙️ ▶ Porsche Connect ▶ Private mode ▶ Activate Privacy Settings/Deactivate Privacy Settings.

Managing and setting

Using services via My Porsche

Activated services can be configured and used via My Porsche (country-dependent).

1. open My Porsche.
(Access can be found at the top left of the Porsche website depending on country.)
2. Log in with personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. Select the **Services** tab.
➔ Available services are displayed.
4. Select the desired service.
5. Activate and configure.

Updating content in PCM

- ▶ **Button HOME** ▶ **APPS** ▶ **Button OPT**
▶ **Reload services**
➔ The contents of the purchased services are updated.

Displaying service messages

- ▶ **Button Apps HOME** ▶ **APPS** ▶ **Button Service OPT** ▶ **information**
➔ Information about the services purchased and the contract duration is displayed.

Log out Porsche Connect user (Porsche ID) in PCM

- ✓ A Porsche Connect user is created and registered.

1. **Button HOME** ▶ **APPS** ▶ **Button OPT**
2. **Logout from Porsche Connect**
➔ The user currently logged in is logged out.

- The Porsche Connect services (including the Car Connect services, but not the Safety and Security services) offer a free inclusive period, which varies in length for each services package and country, but is always at least 3 months. - Depending on the country, the Porsche Connect service can be used via the embedded SIM card or a data-enabled external SIM card. A separate, fee-based contract with a cellphone service provider is required for the external SIM card.
- Additional costs may be incurred for receiving data from the Internet, depending on the cellphone rate plan, particularly when the system is used in foreign countries. We recommend a data flat rate.
- Service availability and scope, as well as service providers, may vary from country to country, model year, device and tariff.

Services at a Glance

Apple CarPlay

Opening Apple CarPlay

Apple CarPlay makes iPhone apps available in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM). You can use the Siri® voice recognition system to send and answer text messages as well as process voice commands.

i Information

- We recommend that you install the latest iOS version.
 - Only those apps in the iPhone you are using that are supported by Apple CarPlay are displayed. For information on supported apps, go to: www.apple.com/ios/carplay.
 - The function can only be offered in countries supported by Apple. For information on supported countries, go to: www.apple.com/ios/feature-availability/#apple-carplay.
 - The displayed content and features of Apple CarPlay are provided solely by the connected iPhone.
 - When Apple CarPlay is used, any active Bluetooth® connections (e.g. for telephony, media playback or news) are automatically disconnected.
- An inserted SIM card cannot be used for making calls while this app is in use.
- Some apps require an active data connection. Additional costs may be incurred, depending on the cellphone rate, particularly when used in foreign countries. We recommend using a data flat rate.

Opening Apple CarPlay™ in PCM



Fig. 2: USB port (Type C) in the armrest

- ✓ iPhone 7 or later, iOS 14 or higher.
- ✓ Siri and Apple CarPlay must be activated in the settings of the iPhone you are using.
- ✓ For proper use, use undamaged genuine Apple cables without USB adapters.

1. Connect the iPhone to the USB interface (type C) **A** (Fig. 2) in the armrest.
2. Confirm that Apple CarPlay is being used.
 - ➔ Apple CarPlay opens. The available apps are displayed.
3. To switch to Apple CarPlay from another menu item, select **APPLE CARPLAY** .
 - or -
 - Select **Apple CarPlay** in status bar.

Operating Apple CarPlay with PCM

All available apps can be operated using the touchscreen, the rotary push button and the Undo button of the PCM.

- ▶ To open the main menu in **Apple CarPlay**, press the Home button on the touchscreen of the PCM.

- ▶ To switch to the main functions of PCM select **APPLE CARPLAY** ▶ Home ▶ **Porsche** button.
 - or -
 - Press any direct selection button (e.g. **MEDIA**).

Operating Apple CarPlay via Siri voice recognition

Starting Siri


- ✓ Siri is activated in the settings of the iPhone you are using.
- ✓ The ignition and PCM are switched on.
- ✓ There are no active phone calls.
- ✓ ParkAssist is not active.
- ✓ PCM voice control is not active.





1. Press and hold the button on the (Fig. 3) control lever.
2. Say the desired voice command.

Ending Siri

- ✓ Siri is active and waiting for a voice command.
 - ▶ Press the  button on the (Fig. 3) control lever.
 - ➔ A fading acoustic signal sounds.

Switching between Apple CarPlay and use of the iPhone as an iPod





Apple CarPlay is not available if the connected iPhone is connected as an iPod. You can switch between using the iPhone as an iPod and Apple CarPlay using the Device Manager.

1. To call up the Device Manager, select  or  (depending on the connection status) in the header.
 - or –
 - Devices** 
2. Select the symbol **Apple CarPlay**  for the iPhone you are using.
 - or –
 - Select the iPod  icon of the iPhone you are using.
 - ➔ The icon for the iPhone's currently active use is highlighted in color.

Opening Wireless Apple CarPlay



Wireless CarPlay (available depending on country) enables the use of Apple CarPlay without cables. Wireless CarPlay only supports one active cellphone at a time.

- ✓ The Bluetooth® and WiFi function of the cellphone is activated and is visible for other devices.
- ✓ Wireless CarPlay is activated on the cellphone.
- ✓ Bluetooth® function and vehicle WiFi function activated.



1. Select  or  (depending on the connection status) in the status area and **Connection manager** ▶ **Apple CarPlay Search** in the menu under Connection Assistant.
 - or –
 - Devices**  ▶ **Link** 
2. Select the device from the list.
3. Confirm that Apple CarPlay is being used.
 - ➔ Apple CarPlay opens.
The available apps are displayed.

After you have connected your iPhone once, Apple CarPlay starts automatically whenever you get into the vehicle. You can leave the cellphone in your bag or trouser pocket, for example (Bluetooth® function and WiFi function must be activated).








To switch from another menu item to Apple CarPlay:

- ▶ **Apple CarPlay**  Select **Apple CarPlay**  in the status area.

Deleting a stored iPhone from the list of devices

1. Select  or  (depending on the connection status) **Options**  in the header.
 - or –
 - Select **devices**  ▶ **Options** 
2. Select the desired device.

Ending Wireless CarPlay

1. Select **devices** 
2. Select the  symbol for the iPhone you are using.
 - ➔ Wireless CarPlay is ended.

Dictation

You can use the **Dictate** service to record a message via voice control.

The voice output can be interrupted for you to speak further voice commands. Activate/deactivate voice interruption in the PCM:

▶ **SET** ▶ **General system settings** ▶ **Interrupt voice control** Select .

Connect phone via Bluetooth®

- ✓ The Bluetooth® function of the cellphone is activated and is visible for other devices.
- ✓ The Bluetooth® function of the PCM is activated.

1. PHONE ▶ Search for new phone

2. Select a cellphone from the device list.
 - ➔ A 6-digit Bluetooth® code is generated and displayed in the PCM and on the cell phone.
3. Compare the Bluetooth® code in the PCM and cell phone.
4. If the Bluetooth® code in the PCM and on the device match, confirm. If necessary, enter the PIN for the external SIM card in the PCM.

- ➔ When the phone is successfully connected, the numeric input (menu **KEYPAD**) is displayed in PCM.

Information

- Depending on the Bluetooth® capability of the cellphone, it is possible to access the content of the phone book, call lists and messages. It is also possible to transfer an ongoing conversation to the cellphone after parking the vehicle and continue it outside the vehicle if the cellphone supports this function.

Connecting a cellphone (Windows® and iOS® operating system)

For cellphones with Windows® and iOS® operating systems, it is recommended to start connection from the cellphone:

1. Search for available devices in the Bluetooth® menu of the cellphone. To make the PCM visible, select or in the header (depending on the connection status).
2. Select the PCM from the list of available devices. The Bluetooth® device name of the PCM can be displayed in the **Device manager** under **Options** ▶ **Bluetooth** ▶ **Bluetooth name**.

Opening voice control

WARNING

Impaired speech recognition

The voice can change in stressful situations. This could lead to the desired phone connection not being established, or not being established fast enough.

- ▶ Do not use voice control in an emergency.
- ▶ Enter the emergency number via the touch display.




Fig. 4: Press the voice control button on the control lever.

Activate voice control


- ✓ Ignition is on.
 - ✓ There are no active phone calls.
 - ✓ ParkAssist not active.
1. Press button on the control lever.
 - ➔ A rising acoustic signal is heard and the symbol for voice control appears on the PCM.
 2. Say the voice command.

Deactivating voice control


- ✓ Voice control is active.

- ▶ Press button  on the control lever.
 - ➔ A fading acoustic signal sounds.

Information

The dialog can be paused by tapping on the microphone symbol  and started again by tapping again.

Further voice control button functions

The  button on the control lever activates different functions, depending on the application:

- Skips a running announcement when pressed briefly.
- Interrupts the current dialog when pressed briefly.
- Activated by pressing and holding Siri® voice recognition.

Information

- Navigation announcements and traffic notices are not issued during a dialog.
- When the voice control function is activated, list entries can be selected using the voice control, the rotary push button or the touchscreen.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, then voice control responds with the question **Excuse me?** and the voice command can be repeated after that.

Notes on communication using voice control

Note the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Do not speak when the voice control is making an announcement.

- Reduce disruptive noises by closing the doors, windows and sunroof, for example.
- The hands-free microphone for voice control is directed toward the driver's side.

Dictate and read out messages

The **Dictation** service can be used, for example, to dictate text messages or e-mails and to play back incoming messages from PCM.

- ✓ Data connection established.
- ✓ Porsche Connect Services activated in My Porsche.
 - ▶ Refer to chapter "Registration and Setup" on page 3.
- ✓ The cellphone supports the function.
- ✓ Voice control is active.

Dictate Messages

Service cannot be used with Apple devices.

- ▶ Say the voice command: **Dictate (new) e-mail**
- or -
Dictate (new) text message
 - ➔ The dictated message is displayed in the PCM for the user to check.

Read out message

- ▶ Say the voice command:
Read out E-Mail
- or -
Read out SMS
 - ➔ The message is read out.

Finder

The **Finder** (availability dependent on country) is the central search function in the navigation of the Porsche Communication Management (PCM). Information on destinations such as restaurants, hotels, petrol stations or car parks can be called up in the Finder.

Destinations can be displayed in the current vicinity, along the route, at the destination or at another location. The selected destination can be adopted as a navigation destination and saved as a favorite.

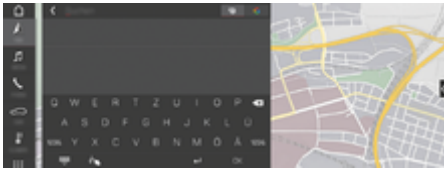


Fig. 5: Finder

- ✓ Data connection established.
- ✓ Porsche Connect Services are activated in My Porsche.

1. **NAV** **Select** in the header.
 - ➔ In addition to the input line, you can switch between an integrated search in the PCM memory and online content and an online search on the Internet.
2. Select destination.
 - ➔ Information such as availability, price information or reviews are displayed.
3. **Calculate route**

Search for point of interest

- ✓ Data connection established.
- ✓ Porsche Connect Services are activated in My Porsche.

1. **NAV** **DEST** **POIs** **Select**.
2. For example, the following categories can be searched:
 - Parking
 - Gas stations
 - Hotels
 - Restaurants
3. Select the icon in the header **Desired option**:

Select the desired option:

 - **POIs nearby**: Displays destinations in the vicinity of the vehicle.
 - **POIs along route**: When route guidance is active, destinations along the route are displayed.
 - **POIs at destination**: When guidance is active, destinations are displayed at the destination.
 - **At another location**: Destinations that are located at a searched location are displayed.

My Porsche App

Setting up and using the app

The app, which is available depending on the country, offers the option of networking the mobile phone with the vehicle (designation and functions subject to change). This allows vehicle-specific information to be retrieved directly using the phone and selected vehicle settings to be made via the app. In addition, the breakdown call can be triggered in the app depending on the country. The following functions, e. g. are available: Current vehicle data such as range and fuel level or retrieving battery status, remotely controlling the locking and unlocking of the vehicle, activating and deactivating air conditioning or pre-heating, managing and sending personal POIs (Points of Interest) to the vehicle, transferring destinations from calendar entries from the phone to the PCM. The App also provides insight into current information on the Porsche brand, such as new products or events.




The availability of app functions depends on the respective vehicle model, model year, vehicle equipment as well as the local availability of the respective function in the offer market.

Connecting app to the PCM via WiFi

The app allows access to vehicle-specific data and other functions. It is recommended that this data be protected from unauthorized access by third parties. Using the app could incur additional costs with your cellphone service provider, as the data is transmitted via cellphone networks.

- ✓ App is installed on the phone (download from Apple App Store or Google Play Store).
- ✓ App started.

- ✓ The phone's WiFi function is activated.
- ✓ The PCM's WiFi function is activated.

1. Select  or  (depending on the connection status) ▶ Options  ▶ PCM Hotspot in the header.
2. In the WiFi settings for the device, enter the displayed WiFi access data for the PCM or scan the displayed QR code with the cellphone.
 - ➔ Connection to the wireless Internet access of the PCM is established.

Communication between the vehicle and app may be suppressed.

Using app functions

In order to use the full range of functions in the app, the following requirements must be met:

- ✓ App connected to PCM.
- ✓ Private mode deactivated.
- ✓ Remote access authorization granted in the PCM.
- ✓ Connect or Car Connect services activated.
- ✓ Authorization granted on mobile device.

Menu navigation

The app menu navigation takes place centrally via the menu items

- Vehicle
- Map
- Browse
- Account

Functions in the Vehicle menu item

Lock

The locking status of doors, windows, tailgate, hood, sunroof and fuel filler cap can be displayed. In addition, the doors and trunk can be locked.


Display lock status

When the vehicle is fully locked, a green tick is displayed above the vehicle symbol in the top left. If one or more vehicle parts are open, this is indicated by a corresponding symbol above the vehicle display at the top left.

1. Select **Vehicle** in the main menu (Home).
2. Select the vehicle symbol at the top left. Opened vehicle parts are displayed.

Lock the vehicle

- ✓ Porsche Entry & Drive
- ✓ Vehicle is stationary and switched off.
- ✓ Driver's door completely closed.
- ✓ Security code My Porsche assigned.

2. Below the vehicle display, select .
3. **Confirm** Select .

Pre-heater on



Inhalation of toxic exhaust gases

The pre-heater burns fuel when switched on. This produces toxic exhaust gases, which are released underneath the vehicle.

- ▶ Do not operate the pre-heater in closed spaces (e.g. in a garage).

⚠ WARNING

Hot exhaust gases

The emissions produced during pre-heater operation are very hot.

- ▶ Switch off the pre-heater before refueling.
- ▶ Park the vehicle so that hot exhaust gases can be discharged without obstruction on the underside of the body and cannot come into contact with easily combustible materials such as grass or leaves.

The pre-heater is used to heat the interior of the vehicle and defrost the windshield when the engine is not running. The vehicle's pre-heater can be controlled remotely using this function.

Information

After the running time, the auxiliary heating is deactivated and is only available again after the engine has been started.



- ✓ Outside temperatures below approx. 68 °F (20 °C).
- ✓ Adequate fuel level (reserve not reached).

Immediate start of Pre-heater

The pre-heater can be started and stopped immediately.

2. Below the vehicle display,  select and confirm the security notice.

 - ▶ Pre-heater is started immediately and adopts the standard temperature set in the app.

Timer

This function can be used to manage the timer-controlled Pre-heater. For the set time, the vehicle strives for the set climatic conditions.

In order to use the full range of functions in the app, the following requirements must be met:

- ✓ Adequate fuel level (reserve not reached).

1. Select **Vehicle** in the main menu (Home).

Manage timer

Up to three timers can be configured and saved. A maximum of one timer can be active. The vehicle interior is heated to the last vehicle temperature set. The desired vehicle temperature is set via the PCM set.

3. Select the desired timer.
4. Edit date / period and time.
5. Select **Complete**.

Activating/deactivating timer

A timer that has already been set can be activated / deactivated. If the timer is activated, the vehicle is air-conditioned until the programmed time.





Real-time Traffic

The **Real-time traffic** service retrieves the current traffic flow online in real time and highlights the roads in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) in color according to the traffic situation.

- Yellow lines: slow-moving traffic
- Red lines: traffic jam

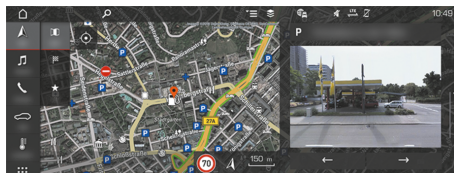


Fig. 8: Panorama View

News

Configuring news and Twitter via My Porsche

Five news feed channels are predefined as standard in the PCM. Additional news feeds can be added individually via My Porsche.

(Access can be found at the top left of the Porsche website depending on country.)
2. Log in with personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. Select **Services ▶ News**.
4. Select the **desired option**:
 - **New** : Adds new news feeds to the list.
 - **SEARCH** : Locates individual news feeds in the news list.
 - **Delete** : Deletes individual news feeds from the list.
 - **Pen icon** : Edits already added news feeds.

Adding new news feeds

1. **New**  Select .
2. Enter the URL of a message portal in the input field.
 - ➔ A suggested list of suitable news feeds is displayed.

3. Continue configuring news feed (enter news feed description) and then select **Save**.

Operating news in the PCM.

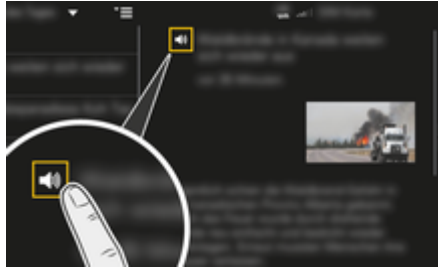




Fig. 9: Using the voice function for messages

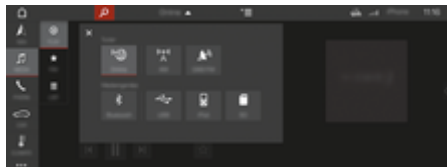


Fig. 11: Radio Plus





This option can be used to display additional meta-data and album covers.

Risk Radar

The Risk Radar service is used to provide local hazard information and traffic sign recognition (availability dependent on country).

The networking of vehicles allows access to shared, anonymized information from other vehicles. The PCM can therefore point out danger zones at an early stage and offers an optimized traffic sign display with constantly updated data.

- ✓ Data connection established.
- ✓ Porsche Connect Services activated in My Porsche.

Activate online navigation

1. NAV ► MAP ► Icon (in the header)
2. Select **Online Navigation**.

Open messages


- ✓ Route guidance active

- NAV ► Traffic
- ➔ The danger zones that are received via the Risk Radar are marked with the symbol .
- A message appears in the multifunction display shortly before the danger zone is passed.

Voice control

The **voice control** service allows selected functions in Porsche Communication Management (PCM) to be operated by voice. The **Voice control** service is not available in all languages and markets.

The voice output can be interrupted for you to speak further voice commands. Activate/deactivate voice interruption in the PCM:

- ▶ **SET**  **Select** ▶ **System settings** ▶ **Voice control** ▶ Interrupt voice control.

Opening voice control

WARNING

Impaired speech recognition



The voice can change in stressful situations. This could lead to the desired phone connection not being established, or not being established fast enough.

- ▶ Do not use voice control in an emergency.
- ▶ Enter the emergency number via the PCM.




Fig. 13: Press the voice control button on the control lever.


Activate voice control

 2. Say the voice command.


Deactivate voice control

- ✓ Voice control is active.
- ▶ Press button  on the control lever.
 - ➔ A fading acoustic signal sounds.

Information

The dialog can be paused by tapping on the microphone symbol  and started again by tapping again.

Further voice control button functions

The  button on the control lever activates different functions, depending on the application:

- Skips a running announcement when pressed briefly.
- Interrupts the current dialog when pressed briefly.
- Activated by pressing and holding Siri® voice recognition.

Information

- Navigation announcements and traffic notices are not issued during a dialog.
- When the voice control function is activated, list entries can be selected using the voice control, the rotary push button or the touchscreen.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, then voice control responds with the question **Excuse me?** and the voice command can be repeated after that.

Notes on communication using voice control

Note the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Do not speak when the voice control is making an announcement.
- Reduce disruptive noises by closing the doors, windows and sunroof, for example.
- The hands-free microphone for voice control is directed toward the driver's side.

Weather

The Weather service can be used to display weather information, e.g. at the destination in Porsche Communication Management (PCM).

Display weather

- **Nearby:** Displays weather information in the vicinity of the vehicle.

Refresh display

► APPS ► Weather ► Options ► **Re-load page**

- ➔ The time of the last update is displayed next to the option.

Display rain radar (availability dependent on country)

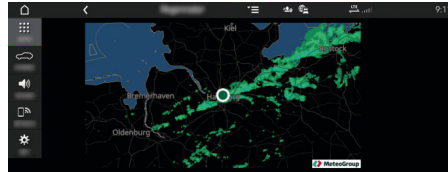


Fig. 15: Rain radar
