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## Registration and Setup

### Important information about Porsche Connect

#### Availability

The availability of Porsche Connect varies depending on the country and equipment. Accordingly, the contents described may differ.

#### Data connection

A data connection is required in order to use Porsche Connect Services. The data connection can be established via the embedded SIM card or an external WiFi hotspot, depending on the country.

#### Information

For legal reasons, customer identity verification is required to use the **integrated SIM card** in some countries. For this purpose, the customer's identity must be verified by means of an identity document before the activation of the Porsche Connect services. Verification is performed by a third-party provider (ID-now) in the form of a video call.

#### Use while driving

If the PCM or other components in the vehicle are operated while driving, there is a risk of being distracted while driving, and it may not be possible to react to dangerous situations in time. For this reason, some functions are only available when the vehicle is stationary.

1. Only use the multi-function steering wheel, infotainment system, etc., while driving if the traffic situation allows you to do so safely. If necessary, stop the vehicle in a safe place.
2. Do not use a cellphone or other mobile device while driving.
3. Only make or receive calls using hands-free equipment.
4. Do not reach between the steering wheel spokes while driving. Otherwise, you may not be able to react in time to dangerous situations.

#### Apps

Various apps are available for your vehicle, depending on the country (download from Apple App Store or GOOGLE® Play Store).

#### WARNING

Setting and operating while driving

Configuring settings and operating apps while driving can distract you from the traffic situation. You may lose control of the vehicle.

- ▶ Operate and adjust settings only while the vehicle is stationary.

### Register and activate My Porsche

My Porsche is the central platform for managing his personal vehicles, using relevant services and a contact point for additional offers. Access to My Porsche is done via the personal Porsche ID.

The Porsche ID is a verified email address that is used by a Porsche Connect user in My Porsche the Porsche Connect Store and in the My Porsche App.

In the Porsche ID account, the user is given the ability to make personal settings regarding data synchronization and processing. The platform also offers other options such as scheduling service appointments.

Availability of services and functions depend on the country and equipment.

### Log in to My Porsche

- ✓ Porsche ID account is activated.

1. Open My Porsche  
(Access is available at the top left of the Porsche website depending on country.)
2. Enter and open the login data (Porsche ID and password).

### Activate Porsche ID account (Porsche Connect user) and Porsche Connect services

- ✓ E-mail was received to activate the Porsche ID account.

1. Click the "Activate Porsche ID Account" button in the e-mail and enter the confirmation code (sent to the stored cellphone number).
2. Set the **password** and **security code** for the Porsche ID account.
3. Complete profile details and activate the free Porsche Connect inclusive period, which is available in some countries. (is automatically performed in the background depending on the country)

#### Information

If no e-mail was received to activate the Porsche ID, please contact your Porsche partner.

### Security code

The assignment of a security code is required for successful registration of the Porsche ID in the vehicle and for the use of some remote services via the app or My Porsche.

1. Access My Porsche.
2. Log in with personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. The security code can be set, changed or reset in the user settings.

Depending on the country, the **security code** must be assigned to use the following services:

- Unlocking the Porsche ID after vehicle entry (if "Log in with security code" is set)
- Change of the login settings in the vehicle (e.g. to "Log in without security code")
- Deactivation of the Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTS)
- Activation of the remote functions for the secondary user

### Configure services

- ✓ Porsche ID account is activated.

1. Open My Porsche
2. Log in with personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. Select the **Services** tab.  
➔ Available services are displayed.
4. Select the desired service.
5. Activate and configure.

#### Information

- The Porsche Connect Service package includes many Porsche Connect services for a free inclusive period, which can be different for each service and country. More information about the free inclusive periods as well as subsequent costs and information about the availability of individ-

ual services for your country is available online at [www.porsche.com/connect](http://www.porsche.com/connect) or from your authorized Porsche dealer.



- Depending on the country, the Porsche Connect services are used via the embedded SIM card or the external WiFi hotspot (only available for Russia).
- Additional costs may be incurred for receiving data from the Internet, depending on the cell-phone rate plan, particularly when the system is used in foreign countries. We recommend a data flat rate.

Service availability and scope, as well as service providers, may vary from country to country, model year, device and tariff.

### Registration of the Porsche ID (Porsche Connect user) in the vehicle

Logging in with the Porsche ID in the vehicle is required for using some of the Porsche Connect services. Logging in calls up personal settings from My Porsche in the vehicle.

- ✓ Porsche Connect user (Porsche ID) created in My Porsche .
- ✓ Security code (see ▷ Refer to chapter "Security code" on page 4.) for Porsche ID created and recognized My Porsche.

1.  ▶ **Settings**  ▶ **Accounts** ▶ **Set up account**
2. Enter the Porsche ID, email address and My Porsche password and confirm with **Login**.

### Add navigation destination

Navigation destinations can be defined either in the My Porsche portal or directly in the vehicle.

#### Adding a navigation destination in the My Porsche portal

- ✓ Porsche ID account is activated.

1. Open My Porsche
2. Log in with personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. Select the **Services** tab.
  - ➔ Available services are displayed.
4. Select **Navigation Plus** service.
5. Select **Add new destination**
6. Enter destination data.
  - ➔ Destination is displayed in My Porsche and can be edited, marked, deleted or sent to the vehicle.

### Establishing a data connection

#### Establishing data connection via an embedded SIM

Establishing data connection via embedded SIM card (availability dependent on country)

- ✓ Private mode deactivated.
  - ▷ S. 7

After operational readiness has been established, the data connection is established automatically.

#### Information

If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- Private mode deactivated.
- The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage blackspot).

- ▷ Restart PCM if necessary.

#### Establishing data connection via external Wi-Fi hotspot

Establishing a data connection via an external WLAN hotspot (only available in Russia)

#### Information

Data connections via external WLAN hotspots can incur additional costs (e.g. due to data roaming).

- ✓ Wi-Fi available from a cellphone or public hotspot.

1. Select **Device Manager** ▶ **Connect new devices** ▶ **Connect vehicle to Wi-Fi network.**

➔ Wi-Fi networks are detected and displayed.

2. Select Wi-Fi hotspot (e.g. public hotspot or Wi-Fi hotspot of the mobile phone) and enter Wi-Fi access data. Be aware of upper and lower case when entering the data.

➔ A connection is established to the external Wi-Fi hotspot.

#### Book data package

To establish an Internet connection for the Wi-Fi hotspot, data packages must be booked.

- ✓ Data connection successfully established via integrated SIM card.
- ✓ Depending on the country, the corresponding data package is booked at
  - ▷ [www.porsche.com/connect](http://www.porsche.com/connect)
  - or at the local mobile communication provider.

Once a data package has been used up, a message appears automatically on the center display.

#### Turn on the WLAN HotspotPCM

Up to eight Wi-Fi devices can be connected to the vehicle hotspot.

- ✓ Data package booked.
- ✓ Wi-Fi function on the smartphone are activated and visible to other devices.

1. Select **Device Manager** ▶ **Connect new devices** ▶ **Connect devices to vehicle hotspot.**

➔ The device name and Wi-Fi password for the PCM are shown on the central display.

2. Enter the displayed Wi-Fi access data PCM in the Wi-Fi settings of the device.

- or -

Scan the QR code displayed in PCM with the device.

- ➔ Connection to the wireless Internet access of the PCM is established.

#### Information

Calendars can also be synchronized if no data package is booked.



## Managing and setting



### Managing Porsche ID (Porsche Connect user)

✓ Porsche ID (Porsche Connect user) logged in.

▶  ▶ **Settings**  ▶ **Accounts** Select the desired account ••• Carry out **action**:

- **Log in with security code** When establishing operational readiness or switching accounts, only the Porsche ID must be confirmed and the security code entered.
- **Log in without security code**: When establishing operational readiness or switching accounts, only the Porsche ID must be confirmed.
- **Automatic Login**: When establishing operational readiness or switching accounts, the Porsche ID is logged in automatically without renewed confirmation.
- **Delete account**: The Porsche ID in the vehicle is deleted.
- **Log off account**: The Porsche ID in the vehicle is logged out. The guest account is activated.

### Displaying service overview



▶  ▶ **Settings**  Select **Privacy and Porsche Connect Settings** ▶ **Overview of all Porsche Connect services**.

➔ Information about the services purchased and the contract duration is displayed.

### Granting remote access authorization

Remote access authorization is required in order to use service control programs in My Porsche the My Porsche App (availability dependent on country) in the vehicle. Remote access is granted automatically when the main user logs in for the first time in the vehicle.

✓ Main user logged into the vehicle at least once.

### Activate private mode

Activating private mode (availability dependent on country)

When private mode is activated, communication between the vehicle and My Porsche App My Porsche is suppressed. No vehicle-specific information is transferred. This means that no vehicle settings can be configured via the app My Porsche.

✓ Remote access authorization granted.

▶  ▶ **Settings**  ▶ **Privacy and Porsche Connect Settings** ▶ **Private Mode**

➔ Private mode can be activated or deactivated for all services, individual services or service groups.

Despite activated private mode, location information for the vehicle can be transmitted in the event of a breakdown or emergency call as well as theft.




Fig. 2: Voice control button on the steering wheel


#### Start Google Assistant

- ✓ Google Assistant is activated in the settings of the phone you are using.
- ✓ The ignition and PCM are switched on.
- ✓ No phone call active.

- ✓ ParkAssist not active.
- ✓ PCM voice control not active.

1. Press and hold the  button on the steering wheel.
2. Say the desired voice command.

#### Exit Google Assistant

- ✓ Google Assistant is active and awaiting a voice command.
- ▶ Press the  button on the steering wheel.
  - ➔ A fading acoustic signal sounds.








### Opening Wireless Android Auto

**Wireless Android Auto** (availability dependent on equipment and country) allows the use of Android Auto without a cable. Wireless Android Auto only supports one active phone at a time.

- ✓ The Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> and WiFi function of the cell-phone is activated and is visible for other devices.
- ✓ Wireless Android Auto of the phone activated.
- ✓ Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> function and vehicle WiFi function activated.

1. Select  or  (depending on the connection status) in the status area and select **Android Auto**  ▶ **Search** in the menu under Connection Manager.  
- or -  
**Devices**  ▶ **Android Auto**   
- or -  
Press and hold the  button on the steering wheel until the search starts.
2. Select the device from the list.
3. Confirm that Android Auto is being used.
  - ➔ Android Auto is called up. The available apps are displayed.

Once the phone has been connected, Android Auto will automatically launch as soon as the phone is in the vehicle.



Alternatively, **Wireless Android Auto** can be connected as follows:

#### **i** Information

- ✓ iPhone 7 or later, iOS 14 or higher.
- ✓ Siri and Apple CarPlay must be activated in the settings of the iPhone you are using.
- ✓ Use an undamaged original cable from Apple without a USB adapter to ensure trouble-free use.

1. Connect the iPhone to the USB interface (Type C) **A** (Fig. 3) in the armrest.
2. Confirm that Apple CarPlay is being used.
  - ➔ Apple CarPlay opens and the available apps are displayed.

- ▶ To switch from a different menu item to Apple CarPlay, select  ▶ **Apple CarPlay** .

2. Say the desired voice command.

#### Ending Siri

- ✓ Siri active and waiting for a voice command.
- ▶ Press the button on the steering wheel.
  - ➔ A fading acoustic signal sounds.

#### Switching between Apple CarPlay and use of the iPhone as an iPod

Apple CarPlay is not available if the connected iPhone is connected as an iPod. You can switch between using the iPhone® as an iPod® and Apple CarPlay™ using the Device Manager.

1. To open the Device Manager, select or (depending on the connection status) in the status area.
  - or -
  - ▶ **Devices** Select.
2. Select the symbol **Apple CarPlay** for the iPhone you are using.
  - or -
  - Select the **iPod** symbol for the iPhone you are using.
    - ➔ The icon for the current iPhone use is highlighted in color and shows the current connection for (**Apple CarPlay** or **iPod**)

### Opening Wireless Apple CarPlay

**Wireless CarPlay** (availability dependent on equipment and country) allows the use of Apple CarPlay without a cable. Wireless CarPlay only supports one active cellphone at a time.




- ✓ The Bluetooth® and WiFi function of the cellphone is activated and is visible for other devices.
- ✓ Wireless CarPlay is activated on the cellphone.
- ✓ Siri activated on the cellphone.
- ✓ Bluetooth®function and vehicle WiFi function activated.

1. Select ▶ **Connect new device** ▶ **Connect Apple CarPlay** in the status area.
  - ➔ Searching for a new device.
2. Select the vehicle in the settings of the cellphone and confirm the connection setup message.
 




If desired, allow the synchronization of contacts and favorites.
3. Confirm the pairing of the device in the PCM.
4. Confirm that Apple CarPlay is being used.
  - ➔ Apple CarPlay opens. The available apps are displayed.

After you have connected your iPhone once, Apple CarPlay starts automatically whenever you get into the vehicle. The phone can therefore remain in the bag, trouser pocket, etc. (Bluetooth®function and WiFi function must be activated).



Alternatively, **Wireless CarPlay** can be connected as follows:

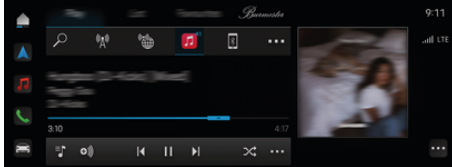


Fig. 5: Apple Music

When setting up Apple Music, the Apple ID is linked to the Porsche ID. Apple Music can be set up via My Porsche, the app or via the center display.

### Set up Apple Music via the center display

1. **Home ▶ Media ▶ Play ▶ QR**
2. Scan the QR code displayed with the mobile phone to link the Apple ID to the center display.

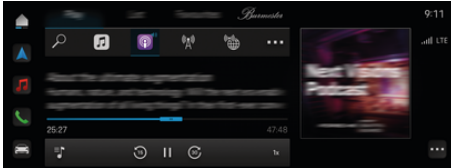


Fig. 6: Apple Podcasts

### Charging Planner

If a destination is entered that is outside of the range, the driver is made aware of this both via an acoustic signal and a text notification. The Charging Planner then automatically adds required E-Stations to the route. E-Stations with an output of at least 50 kW are selected, taking travel and charging times into account.

If an alternative route is selected, the Charging Planner automatically adapts the drive mode to the route (**Normal** or **Range**), and a corresponding notification text appears on the monitor.

E-Stations and the associated charging time are shown in the trip overview.

The high-voltage battery is pre-conditioned to achieve optimum charging performance.

The Charging Planner can also be opened in the Porsche Connect App, and the data can be transferred from your cellphone to the PCM.

### Viewing details on E-Stations

►  ► **Select Navigation**  ► ... ► **Route overview**






The following details on E-Stations are constantly updated and can be viewed:

- Name of the E-Station
- Charge state when the E-Station is reached
- Arrival time at the E-Station
- Distance from the E-Station
- Charging time
- Charge state when the destination is reached

### Viewing dynamic details on Charging Stations


Dynamic details can be changed at short notice by the provider of the charging station, e.g. opening times or payment options.

Show dynamic details when no route guidance has started:

►  ► **Select Navigation**  ► **Enter destination** and tap **Desired charging station** .  
- or -  
 ► **Select Navigation**  ► **Tap the required charging station on the map.**

Show dynamic details in the route monitor:

- ✓ Start route guidance
- ✓ Route monitor open.

► Tap the desired charging station  on the right edge of the screen.



### Entering the E-Station manually

E-Stations can be manually entered as stopovers and final destinations.

A charging time is calculated for manually added E-Stations and adjusted for automatically added E-Stations. The high-voltage battery is pre-conditioned to achieve optimum charging performance.

Manually added E-Stations are shown as blue flags on the map mode, while automatically added E-Stations are shown as white flags.

The high-voltage battery is pre-conditioned to achieve optimum charging performance.

### Porsche Intelligent Range Manager (PIRM)

## Porsche Charging Service

The **Porsche Charging Service** offers unlimited access to an extensive network of public charging infrastructure. Depending on the country, the service can be used via the Charging App and offers the following functions:

- **Find** charging stations nearby or by entering an address, as well as additional useful information.
- Intelligent **navigation** to the selected charging station.
- **Authentication** at the charging station via app, RFID card (Taycan Charging Card) or via Plug & Charge.
- Depending on the charging station with direct current (DC fast charging) or alternating current (AC normal charging) **load**.
- View **Live status** of the charging stations.
- **Charge status** and **history** on the smartphone.

Requirements for using the Porsche Charging Service:

- ✓ Porsche Charging Service in Porsche Connect Store purchased.
- ✓ App is installed on the phone (download from Apple App Store or Google® Play Store).



### Authentication and charging at the charging station

When a charging station is reached, it must be activated and authentication must be carried out.

Depending on availability, the following **activation and authentication methods** are available at a charging station:

- Unlock and authenticate by **Scanning the RFID card** (Taycan Charging Card):
- Unlock and authenticate via **the app by scanning the QR code**:
- Unlock and authenticate via **the app by entering the charging station ID manually (EVSE-ID)**:
- Unlock and authenticate **exclusively via the app**:
- Activation and authentication through **Plug & Charge**. When the charging plug is inserted, the charging process starts automatically.

### Activation/authentication with the Taycan Charging Card

After activating the Porsche Charging Service, the Taycan customer (depending on the country) receives a Taycan Charging Card to use the Porsche Charging Service.

The Taycan Charging Card is equipped with an RFID (radio frequency identification) chip. With this chip, charging processes at charging stations with RFID readers can be activated and authorized.


1. Hold the Taycan Charging Card against the RFID reader of the charging station for a few seconds.
2. Plug in the charging cable.

### Information

If support is required, the contact details for the Porsche Contact Center (PCS) can be found on the Taycan Charging Card.

Charging stations can differ significantly in their appearance. The RFID reader can be located in different places and look different at the charging stations.


### Activation/authentication via the app via QR code

1.  Tap.
2. Scan the QR code on the charging station.
3. Plug in the charging cable and Select *kostenpflichtig bestellen*.

### Information

Sometimes different QR codes can be found on a charging station. The correct QR code shows the *intercharge logo*.

### Activate and authenticate via the app by entering the charging station ID manually (EVSE-ID):

1.  Tap.
2. Tap the *Keyboard* icon in the app.
3. Plug in the charging cable and *kostenpflichtig bestellen* tap.

### Activate/authenticate exclusively via the app

1. Select the charging station.
2. Select the connector type.
3. Choose the exact charging station.
4. Plug in the charging cable and Select **order for a fee**.

### Authentication and charging via Plug & Charge

- ✓ Plug & Charge activated in the vehicle
- ✓ Charging station compatible with plug & Charge
- ▶ Plug in the charging cable.
  - ➔ The vehicle authenticates itself independently.

### Ending the charging process

When the vehicle is fully charged, the charging process ends automatically.

### Canceling the charging process without the app

If the charging process is to be terminated prematurely:

1. Select **Stop** at the charging station.
2. Unplug the charging cable.
3. Close the charging port door.

### Canceling the charging process with the app

If the charging process is to be terminated prematurely:

1. Select **Stop** in the app.
2. Unplug the charging cable.
  - ➔ The app sends a confirmation when the charging process has been successfully checked out.
3. Close the charging port.

### Canceling the charging process on the vehicle

### Information

Charging stations can differ in their appearance and charging process. Before starting the charging process, follow the instructions displayed on the charging station.

If the charging process is to be terminated prematurely:

1. Unlock the vehicle.
2. Press the release button on the vehicle charging port.
  - ➔ Charging is completed.
3. Unplug the charging cable within 20 seconds.
4. Close the charging port door.

The destinations can be displayed online in the current environment, along the route or at the destination. The selected destination can be adopted as a navigation destination and saved as a favorite.

The download is paused when the vehicle is switched off and automatically resumed when it is switched back on. The download time depends on the connection quality. After the download is complete, the activation can be started.

- ✓ Private mode deactivated.

#### Activating Function on Demand (FoD)

After you have purchased the service, a notice appears once on the center display and each time PCM is restarted. The message can be viewed in Notifications at any time and activation started.

#### NOTE

Usage restrictions during activation.

Readiness for operation is blocked. Some of the displays and vehicle functions (e.g. comfort functions or anti-theft protection functions) may not work for a short time.

- ▶ Follow the instructions on the center display, for example, You and all occupants should exit the vehicle.
- ▶ Do **not** use the vehicle during the activation process.
- ▶ Only use the vehicle after activation.

Only one activation process can be started. This activation process **cannot** be interrupted. The activation time depends on the FoD service. As soon as a FoD service has been downloaded, activation starts automatically.

- ✓ Parking lock and parking brake activated.
- ✓ Battery charged sufficiently.
- ✓ No external device is connected to the diagnostic socket
- ✓ If necessary, further conditions may be necessary (doors closed, vehicle locked) these conditions are shown in the center display.

After successful activation, a one-time notice appears on the center display. Full use of the vehicle is possible again.

#### Deactivating Function on Demand (FoD)

- ✓ Data connection successfully established.
- ✓ Porsche Connect and any individual services are activated in My Porsche.
- ✓ FoD service purchased and activated in the vehicle.
- ✓ Private mode deactivated.

- ▶ Deactivate the desired FoD service in My Porsche.
  - ➔ After you have deactivated the service, a message appears once on the center display. A notification about the FoD service also appears.

#### Function on Demand (FoD) activation failed

Errors may occur when carrying out activations. If errors occur, perform the following steps:

1. Switch off and lock the vehicle.
2. Wait for 10 minutes.
3. Turn on the vehicle.
4. Trigger the activation process again by leaving and locking the vehicle.

The severity of the fault caused and its consequences are shown on the center display.

#### NOTE

Damage and usage restriction due to failed online software updates.

Readiness for operation may be blocked depending on the severity of the fault. Displays and vehicle functions may not work.

## Services at a Glance

- ▶ If the vehicle can be driven: Adapt your driving style to the situation.
  - ▶ If the vehicle cannot be driven: Call a roadside assistance service and have the vehicle towed if necessary.
  - ▶ Have the fault rectified immediately at an authorized Porsche dealer. Porsche recommends an authorized Porsche dealer, as they have trained technicians and the necessary parts and tools.

## My Porsche App

### Setting up and using the app

The app, which is available in certain countries, can be used to network the cellphone with the vehicle (name and functions subject to change). This allows vehicle-specific information to be retrieved directly using a cellphone and selected vehicle settings to be configured via the app. In addition, the breakdown call can be triggered in the app, depending on the country. For example, the following functions are available: Call up current vehicle data such as range and fuel level or battery status, control locking and unlocking of the vehicle remotely, activate and deactivate air conditioning or the pre-heater, manage personal POIs (points of interest) and send them to the vehicle, and transfer destinations from cellphone calendar entries to the PCM. In addition, the app provides current information about the Porsche brand, such as new products or events.





The availability of app functions depends on the respective vehicle model, model year, vehicle equipment, and the local availability of the each function on the market.

### Connecting the app to the PCM via WiFi

The app enables access to vehicle-specific data and other functions. It is recommended to protect this data from unauthorized access by third parties. Using the app could incur additional costs with your cellphone service provider, as the data is transmitted via cellular networks.

- ✓ App installed on your cellphone (download from Apple App Store or Google Play Store).
- ✓ App started.

- ✓ The cellphone WiFi function is activated.
- ✓ PCM WiFi function activated.

1. Tap  ► **Devices**  ► ... ► **WiFi settings** ► **Configure a vehicle hotspot.**
2. Calling up WiFi access data for the PCM:  ► **Devices**  ► **Connection manager** ► **Connect to a PCM hotspot.**
  - ➔ The device name and WiFi password for the PCM are displayed.
3. Enter the WiFi access data displayed for the PCM in the WiFi settings for the device, or use your cellphone to scan the QR code shown.
  - ➔ A connection to the wireless Internet access of the PCM is established.

Communication between the vehicle and app can be suppressed.

### Display maintenance

3. Select open or closed lock.
4. Enter security code.
  - ➔ The vehicle doors and the tailgate are unlocked or locked. When locking, the alarm system is activated and the lock symbol is displayed.

### Timer

Depending on equipment, timers can be set for the following functions:

- Precool/heat
- Charging process of the high-voltage battery.

With this function, the timer-controlled air conditioning of the vehicle or the charging process of the high-voltage battery can be managed. The vehicle attempts to achieve the set climatic conditions or the set state of charge for the set time. The vehicle air conditioning planned with the timer is carried out even if the vehicle plug is not connected to the charge port.

Up to three timers can be configured and saved. The desired vehicle temperature is set via the PCM.

In order to use the full range of functions in the app, the following requirements must be met:

- ✓ Private mode deactivated.
- ✓ Remote access authorization granted in the PCM.
- ✓ Sufficient battery charge level (> 10%) (climate timer).
- ✓ Charging equipment connected

### Air conditioning




## Navigation Plus

### Real-time Traffic

The **Real-time traffic** service retrieves the current traffic flow online in real time and highlights the roads on the center display in color-coding according to the traffic situation.

The following traffic flow information is displayed:

- Light-red lines: slow-moving traffic
- Red lines: traffic jam
- Dark red lines: blocked roads

In addition, the navigation map displays notices for road construction, accidents, hazards, etc.

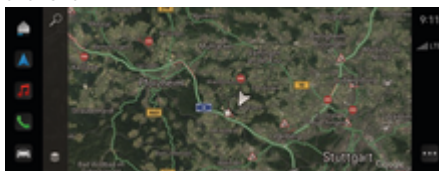


Fig. 10: Map display Satellite map

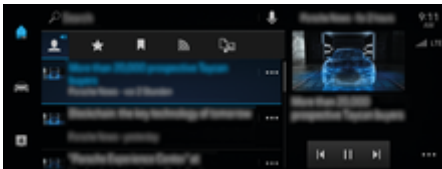







Fig. 11: Use the voice function for news

### Online software update

#### Downloading an online software update

The center display and vehicle can be updated using the online software update function, which is available depending on the country.

Online software updates are automatically downloaded in the background. All center display and vehicle functions can be used without restriction during this time.


- ✓ Porsche Connect Care in the Porsche Connect Store.
- ✓ Online software update is activated in My Porsche.
- ✓ Data connection successfully established.
- ✓ Private mode deactivated.

The download is paused when the vehicle is switched off and automatically resumed when it is switched back on. The download time depends on the connection quality and the content. After the download is complete, the installation can be started.

#### Installing an online software update

When ready for installation, a message about the current online software update appears once and each time the PCM is restarted. The message can be viewed in Notifications at any time and activation started.

No hardware must be plugged into the diagnostic socket during the online software update.

- ▶ For information on the online software update on the home screen, select **Updates** 

#### NOTE

Usage restrictions during the online software update.

**Readiness for operation is blocked.** Some of the displays and vehicle functions (e.g. comfort and charging functions or anti-theft protection functions) may not work for a short time.

- ▶ Park the vehicle safely.
- ▶ Follow the prompts in the PCM, e.g. You and all occupants should exit the vehicle.
- ▶ Do **not** use the vehicle during the online software update.
- ▶ Only use the vehicle after installation.

Only one installation process can be started. This installation process **cannot** be interrupted. The installation time depends on the content of the online software update. An installed online software update **cannot** be reversed.

- ✓ Online software update downloaded successfully.
- ✓ Vehicle switched off.
- ✓ Parking lock and parking brake activated.
- ✓ Battery charged sufficiently.
- ✓ Vehicle exited and locked.
- ✓ Additional conditions may be necessary (e.g. no active charging process). These conditions appear on the center display.

- ▶ Confirm installation of the online software update with **Install now**.

After driving readiness has been reestablished, a one-time notice appears on the center display. Full use of the vehicle is possible again.

#### Information

The installation time is automatically postponed if the installation is not confirmed or if **remind later** is selected.

#### Online software update failed

Faults may occur when carrying out online software updates.

The severity of the fault caused and its consequences are shown on the PCM.

**If errors occur, please observe the relevant information in the PCM.**

#### NOTE

Damage and usage restriction due to failed online software updates.

Displays and vehicle functions may not work.

- ▶ If the vehicle can be driven: Adapt your driving style to the situation.
- ▶ If the vehicle cannot be driven: Call a roadside assistance service and have the vehicle towed if necessary.
- ▶ Have the fault rectified immediately at an authorized Porsche dealer. Porsche recommends an authorized Porsche dealer, as they have trained technicians and the necessary parts and tools.

## Radio Plus

The **Radio Plus** service can be used to select between the integrated Internet radio and hybrid radio. The Internet radio receives radio stations online, the hybrid radio automatically selects the best possible reception.

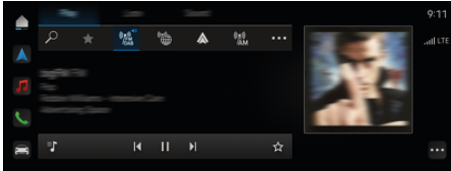


Fig. 12: Radio Plus

With the Internet radio integrated in the PCM you can receive online channels from radio stations.

The **hybrid radio** function enables consistent, perfect reception. If the DAB or FM reception is disrupted due to the environment, the PCM receives the radio station online when the function is activated.

## Smart Service



### WARNING

Setting and operating while driving

Configuring settings and operating the multi-function steering wheel, infotainment system, etc. while driving can distract you from the traffic situation. You may lose control of the vehicle.

- ▶ Only operate these components while driving if the traffic situation allows.
- ▶ If in doubt, stop in a safe place and only perform extensive operations and settings while the vehicle is at a standstill.

## Functions

Some components in the vehicle require regular maintenance or replacement. With the country-dependent Smart Service, maintenance and repair data about these components can be called up and updated. If maintenance or repairs to the components are necessary, a message is displayed on the center display.

## Activating Smart Service

Activation takes place as part of the Connect Care package in the Connect Store. The function is then automatically available in the vehicle.

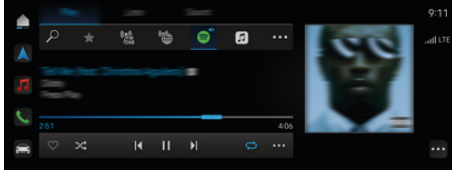


Fig. 14: Spotify

### ⚠ WARNING

Impaired speech recognition

The voice can change in stressful situations. This could lead to the desired phone connection not being established, or not being established fast enough.

- ▶ Do not use voice control in an emergency.
- ▶ Enter the emergency number via the central display.

The voice control system communicates with the driver, thereby providing assistance for using the vehicle and completing various tasks while driving.

It is your helpful companion and can be used interactively. The voice control system acts on and responds to voice input, makes suggestions, performs searches based on your queries, and incorporates environmental data.


Selected air conditioning, ergonomic, media, navigation, and phone functions can be activated, and controlled and used simply and easily via voice commands.

A help function is available in voice control.


### Online mode

- ✓ Data transmission to the cloud approved.
- ✓ Data connection sufficient.
- ✓ Voice control is active.

All voice control functions are available in online mode.

Online mode is indicated by the  symbol on the center display.

If the data connection is inadequate, the PCM automatically switches to offline mode. In offline mode, some voice control functions are available to a limited extent.

If voice control is in offline mode, this is indicated on the center display by the  symbol.


### Using voice control

- ✓ Vehicle ready for operation.
- ✓ No reverse gear selected.
- ✓ No phone call active.
- ✓ ParkAssist not active.




### Starting voice control via the steering wheel





Fig. 15: Steering wheel with voice control button

1. Press the  button on the steering wheel.
  - ➔ An acoustic signal sounds and a window appears on the center display.
2. Say the voice command.


### Starting voice control via the center display

1. Tap  ▶ in the search area  and then type .
  - ➔ An input request sounds and a corresponding window appears on the center display.
2. Say the voice command.
  - ➔ The search results are limited to the currently selected quick filter bar; for example, if the **Media** quick filter bar is selected, only search results for this quick filter bar are displayed.



### Starting voice control by saying "Hey Porsche"

- ✓ "Hey Porsche" is activated:
1.  ▶ **Settings**  ▶ **Voice control** ▶ **Activating with "Hey Porsche"**
  2. Say **Hey Porsche** and the desired voice command.

### Pausing voice control


- ✓ Voice control is active and waiting for a voice command.
- ▶ Tap  in Zentraldisplay.
    - ➔ The dialog is paused and can be restarted by tapping again.

### Ending voice control

- ✓ Voice control is active and waiting for a voice command.
- ▶ Press the  button on the steering wheel.
  - or –
  - Say **Cancel**.
  - or –
  - Tap outside the window.
  - or –
  -  tap in the PCM.
- ➔ A fading acoustic signal sounds.



### Interrupting voice control via a button

Voice responses of the voice control system can be interrupted during the dialog.


- ▶ Briefly press the  button on the steering wheel.

### Interrupting voice responses via voice control


The voice responses of the voice control system can be interrupted during the dialog in order to say other voice commands or execute voice commands immediately, for example. The function is activated in the Zentraldisplay.

- ▶  ▶ **Settings**  **Voice control** Tap **Interrupt voice control**.

### Starting external voice control (e.g. Siri or Google Assistant)

- ▶ Refer to chapter "Apple CarPlay" on page 11.
- 1. Press and hold the  button on the steering wheel.
- 2. Say the desired voice command.

### Ending external voice control (e.g. Siri or Google Assistant)

- ▶ Refer to chapter "Apple CarPlay" on page 11.
- ▶ Press the  button on the steering wheel.
  - ➔ A fading acoustic signal sounds.

### Information

- Navigation and traffic notices are not issued during a dialog.
- With voice control active, list entries can be selected using voice control, the rotary push button or the touch display.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, then voice control responds with the question **Excuse me?** and the voice command can be repeated after that.

### Notes on communication using voice control

Note the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Reduce disruptive noises by closing the doors, windows and sunroof.
- Voice control is optimized for the driver.

### Using natural voice commands

The voice control system is operated using natural voice commands and can work using various types of spoken commands.

- Use natural instructions, such as "Set air conditioning to 72 °F (22 °C).", "Switch on Shiatsu massage.", or "Drive me to San Francisco, Main Street."
- Express needs, such as "There's a draft" or "I need to recharge", or "I'm hungry."
- Use situational voice commands, such as "Avoid the motorway.", or "Find me a bakery along the route."
- Ask for information, e.g. "What's my battery charge level?", or "What's the weather like in San Francisco?"
- Use general search queries or questions, e.g. "What can I do in the Media area?", or "How does voice recognition work?"
- Use main functions, e.g. "I would like to see the map.", or "Show my contacts."
- Press and hold your desired destination and say "Hey Porsche, drive me there." Say .

### Generally valid voice commands

The following voice commands can be said at any point in the dialog:

- Correction
- Pause
- Cancel
- Help

## Navigating lists via voice control

### Browsing through lists

- ✓ Voice control is active.
- ▶ Say **Next page/Previous page**.

### Selecting an entry from the list

Line numbers and list entries displayed in blue in the center display can be spoken and therefore selected.

- ✓ Voice control is active.
- ▶ Say **line 1**.  
– or –  
Say a list entry.

## Multimodal map



The multimodal map enables interaction between the voice control and the map during navigation. This enables a faster and more diverse target search by voice.

When activating by voice control, it does not matter which menu in the PCM is accessed.

### Activating the multimodal map using voice control

- ✓ Voice control is active.
- ▶ Say **I would like to plot a route on the map**  
– or –  
Say **Show me the multimodal map**.
- ➔ The map appears and has a blue frame.

### Activating the multimodal map manually

1.  ▶ **Select Navigation** 
2. Starting voice control
- ➔ The map has a blue frame.

## Examples of commands

These are not complete lists and show only some of the possible natural voice commands and instructions for the voice control system. A good data connection improves search results and speeds up the search.

### Air conditioning system/Comfort functions

- Set seat heating to level 2.
- The windshield is fogged up
- I would like a massage
- Change the ambient light to red
- Set the rear temperature to 24 °C.
- Set the seat ventilation on the passenger side to level 2.

### Navigation/while driving/Finder

- Drive me to the Porsche Museum
- When should I charge?
- Find a restaurant along the route/at the destination
- How much longer will it take?
- Find me a parking lot.
- Drive me to work.
- Where have I driven to recently?
- Drive me to Porsche Street 911 in Weissach.

### Media

- Play the song "Get a Life" from Porsche Sounds, for example
- Play Michael Jackson's album 'Bad'.
- What am I listening to now?
- I would like to search for music
- Play Nelly Furtado in Apple Music
- Play SWR 3.

- Next track.
- I would like to choose a different source

### Phone

- ✓ No phone call active.
- Please call John Doe.
- Dial 0711 911, for example
- Try Andy Forbes again
- Show my call history.
- I would like to connect a new phone (only possible when stationary).

### Reacting to previous dialogs

- ✓ Voice control is active.

It is possible to react to an older dialog of a main function (e. g. Phone) using other voice commands:

- Please call John Doe again

### Multimodal map



- ✓ Destination selected (pin set on map).
- Drive me there.
- Look for a restaurant in the area here.
- Find me bakeries in the area.
- Find me a post office there.

## Voice control help

The system can assist in different ways, questions can be asked or specific issues can be raised.

- I need help (general)
- How does voice control work?
- What can I do in the navigation area?
- What can you do?

### Changing voice control settings

▶  ▶ **Settings**  **Voice Control** Select the desired setting.

## Weather

With the **weather** service, weather information such as at the destination can be shown on the center display.

### Display weather

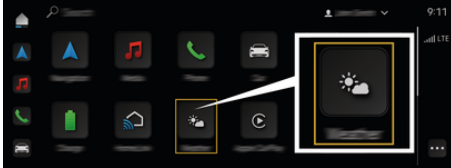


Fig. 16: Weather
